- 6 Rules as Adopted
- 7 7873.0185 TRIFECTA.
- 8 Subpart 1. Scope. The trifecta is a form of pari-mutuel
- 9 wagering combining three horses in a single race. Each bettor
- 10 selects horses that will finish in exact order, first, second,
- 11 and third in a designated trifecta race. Payment of the ticket
- 12 shall be made only to the purchasers who have selected the exact
- 13 order of finish as officially posted, except as otherwise
- 14 noted. All trifecta wagers are calculated on a separate
- 15 trifecta pool, with no relation to any other pool.
- 16 Subp. 2. Price of tickets. Trifecta tickets shall be sold
- 17 singly in not less than \$2 denominations. A box or wheel
- 18 resulting in a minimum wager of \$6, may be made and will return
- 19 to the bettor one-half of the minimum payoff.
- Subp. 3. Scratches. If a horse is scratched or declared a
- 21 nonstarter, no further trifecta tickets may be issued
- 22 designating the horse and all previously issued trifecta tickets
- 23 that include the scratched horse shall be refunded at any time
- 24 and the money deducted from the gross pool.
- Subp. 4. Failure to select winning combination. Items A
- 26 to F govern payoffs in races where the winning combination has
- 27 not been selected.
- 28 A. If no ticket is sold correctly selecting in exact
- 29 order the first three horses, the net pool shall be paid equally
- 30 on those trifecta tickets correctly selecting the first two
- 31 horses in exact order with all other horses.
- 32 B. If no ticket is sold correctly selecting the first
- 33 and second horse, the net pool shall be paid equally on those
- 34 trifecta tickets selecting the horses that finished first and
- 35 third, with all other horses finishing second.

- C. If no ticket is sold correctly selecting the first
- 2 and third horse, the net pool shall be paid equally on those
- 3 trifecta tickets correctly selecting the horses that finished
- 4 second and third, with all other horses to win.
- 5 D. If no ticket is sold correctly selecting the first
- 6 and third horse, the net pool shall be paid equally on those
- 7 trifecta tickets selecting the horse that finished first, with
- 8 all other horses finishing second and third.
- 9 E. If no ticket is sold that would require
- 10 distribution of the net trifecta pool as described in items A to
- 11 D, a full refund of the trifecta pool for that race shall be
- 12 made.
- F. If less than three horses finish a trifecta race,
- 14 payoff shall be made on tickets selecting the actual finishing
- 15 horses in order, ignoring the balance of the selection.
- 16 Subp. 5. Cancellation of trifecta race. If a trifecta
- 17 race is canceled, a full refund of all trifecta tickets will be
- 18 made.
- 19 Subp. 6. Dead heat. Items A to E govern payoffs in dead
- 20 heats.
- 21 A. In the event of a dead heat for first, the winning
- 22 combinations shall include the first two horses as finishing in
- 23 either the first or second position and the horse finishing
- 24 third. The payoffs will be calculated as a place pool.
- B. In the event of a dead heat for second, the
- 26 winning combinations shall be the horse finishing first and the
- 27 two horses finishing in a dead heat for second, as finishing in
- 28 either the second or third position. The payoffs will be
- 29 calculated as a place pool.
- 30 C. In the event of a dead heat for third, the winning
- 31 combinations shall be the horse finishing first, the horse
- 32 finishing second, and the two horses finishing in a dead heat
- 33 for third. The payoffs will be calculated as a place pool.
- D. In the event of a dead heat for first, second, or
- 35 third where there is no winning ticket on the one dead heat
- 36 combination, the entire net pool will be paid to the other

- l winning combination.
- 2 E. In all instances of multiple dead heats, the
- 3 winning combinations shall be paid proportionately from the net
- 4 trifecta pool.
- 5 Subp. 7. Restrictions on trifecta races. The restrictions
- 6 in items A to D apply to trifecta races.
- 7 A. Coupled entries and mutuel fields are prohibited
- 8 in trifecta races.
- 9 B. There must be a minimum of ten horses entered in a
- 10 race with trifecta wagering.
- 11 C. There shall be no trifecta wagering on handicap
- 12 races.
- D. If fewer than eight horses are declared starters,
- 14 trifecta wagering shall be canceled and all trifecta wagers
- 15 shall be refunded. If time permits, the association may
- 16 schedule exacta wagering in place of trifecta wagering.
- 17 Subp. 8. Displaying trifecta rules. Trifecta rules shall
- 18 be prominently displayed at each track conducting trifecta
- 19 wagering. Printed copies of trifecta rules shall be provided to
- 20 patrons upon request.
- 21 7873.0186 TWIN TRIFECTA.
- 22 Subpart 1. Scope. The twin trifecta is a form of
- 23 pari-mutuel wagering in which the bettor selects the three
- 24 horses that will finish first, second, and third in each of two
- 25 consecutive designated twin trifecta races in the exact order as
- 26 officially posted. All twin trifecta wagers will be calculated
- 27 in an entirely separate pool, with no relation to any other pool.
- 28 Subp. 2. Price of tickets. Twin trifecta tickets shall be
- 29 sold in not less than \$2 denominations.
- 30 Subp. 3. Procedures. The procedures in items A to E apply
- 31 to twin trifecta races.
- 32 A. Each bettor purchasing twin trifecta tickets shall
- 33 designate selections as the first three horses to finish in
- 34 exact order in the first race of the two designated races.
- 35 B. After wagering closes for the first race of the

- 1 twin trifecta, the net pool will be divided with 25 percent of
- 2 the net pool going to the first race of the twin trifecta and 75
- 3 percent of the net pool going to the second race of the twin
- 4 trifecta.
- 5 C. After the official declaration of the first race
- 6 of the twin trifecta, 25 percent of the net pool will be
- 7 distributed to the holders of the twin trifecta tickets
- 8 selecting the first three horses in exact order, on the first
- 9 designated twin trifecta race. Further, each bettor holding a
- 10 ticket correctly selecting the first three horses in the exact
- 11 order of finish must, before the running of the second twin
- 12 trifecta race, exchange the winning tickets for both the
- 13 monetary value as calculated by the totalisator equipment and
- 14 twin trifecta exchange tickets and at such time shall select
- 15 three horses to finish in the second race of the twin trifecta
- 16 in the exact order as officially posted. No further money shall
- 17 be required of the holders of the winning tickets in order to
- 18 make the exchange.
- 19 D. After the official declaration of the second race
- 20 of the twin trifecta, the remaining 75 percent of the net pool
- 21 will be distributed to the holders of the second half twin
- 22 trifecta tickets selecting the first three horses in exact
- 23 order, on the second designated twin trifecta race.
- 24 E. If a winning twin trifecta ticket from the first
- 25 race is not presented for cashing and exchange within the time
- 26 provided, the bettor may still collect the monetary value of the
- 27 ticket, but forfeits all rights to any distribution of the
- 28 second race net pool of the twin trifecta.
- Subp. 4. Failure to select the winning combination. Items
- 30 A to C govern payoffs in races where the winning combination has
- 31 not been selected.
- 32 A. In the first race of the twin trifecta only, if no
- 33 ticket is sold correctly selecting in order the first three
- 34 horses, the net pool for the first race shall be distributed
- 35 according to part 7873.0185, subpart 4, governing failure to
- 36 select winning trifecta combinations. However, tickets paid in

- l these instances are not eligible to exchange for second race
- 2 twin trifecta tickets. The second race twin trifecta net pool
- 3 will automatically carry over in this case.
- B. If a full refund is required under part 7873.0185,
- 5 subpart 4, item E, any previous day's carryover will not be
- 6 included and will carry over to the next consecutive race day.
- 7 C. In the second race of the twin trifecta only, if
- 8 no ticket is exchanged correctly selecting the first three
- 9 horses in exact order, the entire net pool for the second race
- 10 of the twin trifecta shall be carried over to the next
- 11 consecutive race day and combined with that race day's second
- 12 race twin trifecta pool. Distribution of this combined second
- 13 race twin trifecta pool will be made only upon the accurate
- 14 selection, in exact order, of the first three officially
- 15 declared finishers of the second twin trifecta race that day.
- 16 Subp. 5. Scratches. If a horse is scratched or declared a
- 17 nonstarter in the first race of the twin trifecta races, no
- 18 further twin trifecta tickets may be issued designating the
- 19 horse and all previously issued twin trifecta tickets, that
- 20 include the scratched horse, shall be refunded and the money
- 21 deducted from the gross pool.
- 22 If a horse is scratched in the second race of the twin
- 23 trifecta races, public address announcements will be made and
- 24 adequate time will be allowed for the exchange of tickets on the
- 25 scratched horse. For the second race of the twin trifecta only,
- 26 all horses will be declared starters once the starting gate has
- 27 opened. In this instance the prevention to start rule will not
- 28 apply.
- Subp. 6. Dead heat. In the event of a dead heat in either
- 30 the first or second race of the twin trifecta, all twin trifecta
- 31 tickets selecting the correct order of finish, counting a horse
- 32 in a dead heat as finishing in any position dead heated, shall
- 33 be winning tickets.
- 34 Subp. 7. Mandatory payout. On the final program of any
- 35 official race meeting, the entire accumulated second race twin
- 36 trifecta net pool must be distributed. In the event, on the

- 1 final program, no second half twin trifecta tickets correctly
- 2 select the officially declared first three finishers in exact
- 3 order, then all second half twin trifecta tickets on that
- 4 specific race shall be declared winners and the pool shall be
- 5 distributed equally among them. In the event no tickets from
- 6 the first race of the twin trifecta are eligible for exchange
- 7 under the rules governing twin trifecta wagering, the
- 8 accumulated second race twin trifecta net pool will not be paid
- 9 out and the pool shall be deposited in a trust account by the
- 10 association, and the pool, as well as all accrued interest,
- 11 shall be carried over and included in the second race twin
- 12 trifecta pool for the next succeeding live racing date as an
- 13 additional net amount to be distributed.
- With the permission of the commission before the start of
- 15 racing, a licensee may declare a mandatory payout on the next
- 16 consecutive race day after the twin trifecta carryover pool has
- 17 reached a previously approved amount. In this instance, if no
- 18 bettor correctly selects in exact order the officially declared
- 19 first three finishers of the second race, then all second race
- 20 twin trifecta tickets on that race shall be declared winners and
- 21 shall share equally in the net cumulated pool minus an amount
- 22 previously approved by the commission, which will be carried
- 23 over to the pool for the second race of the twin trifecta on the
- 24 next consecutive race day. In the event there are no tickets
- 25 from the first race of the twin trifecta that are eligible for
- 26 exchange under the rules governing twin trifecta wagering, the
- 27 accumulated second race net pool will not be paid and will be
- 28 carried over to the second race twin trifecta on the next
- 29 consecutive race day.
- 30 Subp. 8. Cancellation of one or both twin trifecta races.
- 31 If for any reason the first race of the twin trifecta is
- 32 canceled, a full refund of all twin trifecta tickets will be
- 33 made. If fewer than three horses finish the first race of the
- 34 twin trifecta, payoff shall be made equally on tickets selecting
- 35 the actual finishing horses in order, ignoring the balance of
- 36 the selection. In this event, there will be no exchange for the

- l second race of the twin trifecta and the second race net pool
- 2 will automatically carry over to the next consecutive race day.
- 3 If for any reason, the second race of the twin trifecta is
- 4 canceled, not declared official, or less than three horses
- 5 finish the race, the winning ticket holders on the first race of
- 6 the twin trifecta will be entitled to equal distribution of the
- 7 amount of the current program's net pool for the second half of
- 8 the twin trifecta. The cumulative pool from previous programs
- 9 shall not be distributed in this case and will be carried over
- 10 to the next consecutive race day.
- 11 Subp. 9. Restrictions on twin trifecta races. The
- 12 restrictions in items A to D apply to twin trifecta races.
- 13 A. Coupled entries and mutuel fields are prohibited
- 14 in twin trifecta races.
- B. There must be a minimum of ten horses entered in a
- 16 race with twin trifecta wagering.
- 17 C. There shall be no twin trifecta wagering on
- 18 handicap races.
- D. If fewer than eight horses are declared starters
- 20 for the first race of the twin trifecta, twin trifecta wagering
- 21 shall be canceled for that day and all twin trifecta wagers
- 22 shall be refunded. However, any accumulated second race twin
- 23 trifecta carryover will not be affected and will carry over to
- 24 the next consecutive race day. In the event this occurs on the
- 25 final program, the accumulated net pool of the second twin
- 26 trifecta race will be deposited in a trust account by the
- 27 association, and the pool, as well as all accrued interest,
- 28 shall be carried over and included in the second race twin
- 29 trifecta net pool for the next consecutive racing date as an
- 30 additional net amount to be distributed.
- 31 If fewer than eight horses are declared starters for the
- 32 second race of the twin trifecta, all holders of exchange
- 33 tickets to the second race of the twin trifecta will share
- 34 equally in that part of the second race net pool added in that
- 35 day. The amount carried over from previous days will not be
- 36 distributed and will be carried over to the next consecutive

- 1 race day. In the event this occurs on the final program, the
- 2 accumulated net pool of the second twin trifecta race will be
- 3 deposited in a trust account by the association, and the pool,
- 4 as well as all accrued interest, shall be carried over and
- 5 included in the second race twin trifecta net pool for the next
- 6 consecutive racing date as an additional net amount to be
- 7 distributed.
- 8 Subp. 10. Displaying twin trifecta rules. Twin trifecta
- 9 rules shall be prominently displayed at each track conducting
- 10 twin trifecta wagering. Printed copies of twin trifecta rules
- 11 shall be distributed to patrons upon request.
- 12 7877.0120 FEES.

- 14 Subp. 2. Fingerprint charge. In addition to the license
- 15 fee in subpart 1, each initial application for a Class C
- 16 license, and each renewal application every third year
- 17 thereafter, shall be accompanied by a completed FBI fingerprint
- 18 card taken by the commission and a cashier's check or money
- 19 order in the amount established by the Association of Racing
- 20 Commissioners International or the Federal Bureau of
- 21 Investigation. Any horse owner who does not make application in
- 22 person must meet all requirements of this subpart, except that
- 23 the owner may file a completed fingerprint card taken by a law
- 24 enforcement agency. This subpart does not apply to applications
- 25 submitted by persons under the age of 18.

- 27 7877.0170 DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF CLASS C LICENSEES.

- 29 Subp. 3. Jockeys and apprentice jockeys. Jockeys and
- 30 apprentice jockeys shall have the following responsibilities.
- 31 [For text of items A to K, see M.R.]
- 32 L. A jockey must wear the racing colors provided by
- 33 the owner of the horse he or she is to ride, plus solid white
- 34 riding pants, top boots, and a number on the right shoulder
- 35 corresponding to the mount's number as shown on the saddle cloth

- l and in the daily program. No symbols, words, or emblems shall
- 2 be worn which, in the opinion of the commission, are not in
- 3 keeping with the customs of the turf or are employed for
- 4 advertising or promotional purposes.

- 7 Subp. 8. Horsepersons' bookkeeper. It shall be the
- 8 responsibility of the association to administer the
- 9 horsepersons' accounts by providing the services of a
- 10 horsepersons' bookkeeper who shall be bonded in the amount of
- 11 \$100,000.
- 12 The association must establish an interest-bearing trust
- 13 account for the horsepersons' accounts. The horsepersons' trust
- 14 account shall be separate and distinct from any other account.
- 15 Deposits made into the horsepersons' trust account by the
- 16 association are the property of the horsepersons' trust account
- 17 and not of the association.
- 18 The horsepersons' bookkeeper shall be the custodian of the
- 19 horsepersons' trust account and shall keep accurate records of
- 20 all receipts, deposits, and disbursements and make those records
- 21 available at all times for inspection by the commission. The
- 22 horsepersons' bookkeeper shall not distribute any purse money to
- 23 a person with an emergency license.
- The association must deposit into the horsepersons' account:
- A. by the end of the business day following the date
- 26 of the race in which purses are earned, an amount to cover all
- 27 of its obligations including breeders fund purse supplements,
- 28 other supplements, guarantees, stated purses of official races,
- 29 and, when due, any other payments that the association has
- 30 agreed to make including agreements entered into under Minnesota
- 31 Statutes, section 240.13, subdivision 5, paragraph (b); and
- B. by the end of the business day following the date
- 33 of receipt by the association, all stakes, entrance money,
- 34 starting fees, purchase money in claiming races, and deposits
- 35 made by other parties.
