
FIGURE 1: MEASUREMENT OF BRIDGE BETWEEN UNDERCOPINGS

"Abandonment" means the 8 9 abandoning of an existing bridge. Subp. la. Agency. "Agency" means a county, municipality, 10 11 or township. 12 Subp. 2. Bridge. "Bridge" is defined as a structure 13 including supports erected over a depression or an obstruction such as water, highway, or railway, having a track or passageway 14 for carrying traffic or other moving loads, and having an 15 opening measured horizontally along the center of the roadway of 16 ten feet or more between undercopings of abutments, between 17 spring line of arches, or between extreme ends of openings for 18 19 multiple boxes. Bridge also includes multiple pipes where the clear distance between openings is less than half of the smaller 20 contiguous opening. Illustrations of measurements are shown as 21 22 Figures 1 to 4. This definition of a bridge includes, for

23 application of parts 8810.8000 to 8810.8500, only those railroad 24 bridges over or under a public highway or street.



FIGURE 2: MEASUREMENT OF STRUCTURE BETWEEN SPRING LINES








10 FEET OR GREATER Between Extreme end openings of multiple box culverts

"Construction" means the Subp. 4. 3 construction of a road, street, or bridge to replace an existing 4 deficient bridge or a bridge that has been destroyed. 5 [For text of subps 5 to 7, see M.R.] Subp. 8. Road systems defined. "Other roads or streets" 6 means those local roads and streets, not on the state-aid 7 system, under the jurisdiction of the counties, municipalities, 8 and townships. 9 "State-aid" means the system of roads and streets 10 11 established and designated by the commissioner under the 12 jurisdiction of a county or urban municipality. Purpose. The purpose of parts 8810.8000 to 19 8810.8500 is to carry out the mandate of the legislature and to 20 implement that mandate as set forth in Minnesota Statutes, section 174.50. 21 22 Subp. 2. Scope. The scope of parts 8810.8000 to 8810.8500 23 is intended to be confined within the framework of and 24 consistent with Minnesota Statutes, section 174.50. 25 8810.8110 ELIGIBILITY; RESTRICTION. For purposes of eligibility for funding under parts 26 8810.8000 to 8810.8500, some restrictions apply as follows: 27 28 A. Railroad bridges are eligible only if they are under the jurisdiction of a local unit of government. The 29 30 replacement of a private bridge owned by a railroad company is not eligible. 31 B. Subpart 1. Counties. The county board in cooperation with other local units of government within the county, other than urban municipalities, shall determine a proposed program for the construction or reconstruction of key bridges within the county other than urban municipal or trunk highway bridges.

6 This county board by resolution shall request of the 7 commissioner authorization to construct or reconstruct specific 8 bridges or remove an abandoned bridge within the county and 9 request funding.

When local units of government cannot reach agreement with the county board, the local units of government may apply independently. Then the local unit of government by resolution shall request of the commissioner authorization to construct or reconstruct specific bridges or remove an abandoned bridge and request funding.

Subp. 2. Urban municipalities. The city council by resolution shall request of the commissioner authorization to construct or reconstruct specific bridges or remove an abandoned bridge within the municipality and request funding. [For text of subp 3, see M.R.]

The commissioner shall submit the application of the agencies to the proper regional development commission or metropolitan council, as the case may be, for review of consistency with long-term comprehensive development plans and guides for which the agencies are responsible.

28 8810.8400 ESTABLISHMENT OF PRIORITIES.

The commissioner, using information furnished by the local units of governments from the statewide bridge inventory, shall establish a statewide priority of bridge construction or reconstruction.

33 This priority must be based on the relative seriousness of 34 each bridge's deficiencies as determined from the inventory and 35 appraisal after considering the following criteria established
