6 Rules as Adopted

7 3700.0765 ELECTRONICS TECHNOLOGY LICENSE.

8 Subpart 1. **May teach.** A teacher who has an electronics
9 technology instructor license may teach in the electronics
10 technology programs and may also teach:

11 A. electronics core; and

12 B. any course which is electronic theory or
13 application.

14 Subp. 2. **Other requirements.** The applicant must meet the
15 requirements in part 3700.0100 and the requirements for a
16 teacher in the technical occupational area under part 3700.0700.

17 Subp. 3. **Educational and occupational experience**
18 **requirement.** The applicant must have the educational and
19 occupational experience described in items A and B:

20 A. a minimum of two years of education in electronics
21 technology from an accredited postsecondary institution
22 resulting in a diploma, certificate, or degree; and

23 B. 6,000 hours of occupational experience in
24 installation, maintenance, troubleshooting, and repair of
25 electronic circuitry in any of the following areas:

26 (1) computer systems;

27 (2) industrial electronics;

28 (3) manufacturing electronics;

29 (4) electronic communications;

30 (5) biomedical electronics; or

31 (6) consumer electronics.

32 Subp. 4. **Substitution for recent occupational experience.**

33 Teaching experience at an accredited postsecondary institution,
34 industrial, business, or military setting in primary program
35 content in electronics technology may be substituted for 1,500
