7 3300.0100 DEFINITION OF TERMS.

9 Subp. 9. **Support services.** "Support services" means  
10 services which are necessary to enable an eligible individual to  
11 participate in employment and training funded under the act.  
12 Support services may include transportation, child care, meals,  
13 temporary shelter, reasonable and necessary safety equipment,  
14 required uniforms, and other normal expenses associated with  
15 employment and training funded under the act.

16 Subp. 10. **Transitional services.** "Transitional services"  
17 means services which help eligible youth complete school,  
18 upgrade basic skills, and prepare for additional schooling or  
19 permanent employment. Transitional services may include  
20 counseling, case management, basic skills training and remedial  
21 education, life skills training, mentoring and tutoring  
22 services, and work readiness skills training.

23 3300.0500 OPERATION PROCEDURES.

25 Subp. 2a. **Transitional services.** Contractors may provide  
26 or arrange for transitional services to help eligible youth  
27 complete school, upgrade basic skills, and prepare for  
28 additional schooling or permanent employment.

30 3300.0601 SUPPORT SERVICES.

31 Contractors may provide or arrange for support services as  
32 defined in part 3300.0100, subpart 9, to eligible youth, using  
33 funds allocated under this act. The cost of the support  
34 services must not exceed 15 percent of the contract.

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1 Contractors shall not be required to provide support services to  
2 eligible youth when funds received under the act have been  
3 exhausted.
