4830.7000 SCOPE. 7

8 Parts 4830.7010 to 4830.7020 apply to the program of state 9 grants for licensed practical nurses.

4830.7010 APPLICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FOR GRANTS. 10 11 Subpart 1. Application by schools and programs. A school 12 or program that desires nursing grant funds for licensed practical nurses must submit to the executive director by 13 January 1 each year a completed application form provided by the 14 executive director. 15

Subp. 2. Modification of allocations. The executive 16 director shall allocate funds equal to the school's or program's 17 estimated need for funds if the estimated need is less than the 18 19 amount determined by the allocation formula.

Subp. 3. Responsibility. Each participating school or 20 21 nursing program must:

22 A. provide the executive director by the first working day after May 31 each year with the just or nearly 23 completed academic year's enrollment data of licensed practical 24 nurses in educational programs leading to licensure as a 25 licensed registered nurse; 26

B. establish procedures for students to apply for and 27 receive grants; 28

C. establish criteria to use in awarding nursing 29 grants, which must include consideration of the likelihood of a 30 student's success in completing the nursing educational program; 31 32 and

D. give priority to students with the greatest 33 financial need. 34 Subp. 4. Delay. A participating institution that fails to

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submit the annual application for participation to the executive
director or provide requested enrollment data by the deadline
dates may result in the delay of notification and allocation by
the executive director.

5 Subp. 5. Accountability. Each participating school and nursing program is accountable for any money disbursed to 6 7 students for nursing grants for licensed practical nurses. The money may be used only during the fiscal year of disbursement. 8 If a student does not use a grant because the student does not 9 enroll or withdraws from school, the school may use the funds 10 for other eligible students or must return the funds to the 11 12 executive director.

13 Subp. 6. Unused funds. When requested by the executive 14 director, a school or nursing program shall report on its use of 15 funds and shall return unused funds. The executive director 16 shall reallocate unused funds to schools or nursing programs 17 that desire additional funds.

18 4830.7020 REPORTS OF DATA.

Subpart 1. Annual reports. The school or nursing program must collect demographic, educational, and financial data specified by the executive director from eligible students requesting grants, and provide this data upon request to the executive director.

The executive director shall require end of the year 24 25 program activity and student data reports. The school or nursing program must complete and submit the reports and any 26 applicable refunds to the executive director by the first 27 28 working day after August 9. If the reports are not completed correctly and submitted by the deadline, the executive director 29 shall withhold the subsequent year's allocation until reporting 30 requirements are fully met. 31

32 Subp. 2. Additional information. The executive director 33 or the executive director's agent may require additional 34 information not inconsistent with law that in the executive 35 director's judgment is helpful to efficiently administer the

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program. The additional information may be required from grant
applicants or recipients or eligible institutions or programs.

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
