- 7 4830.6500 SCOPE.
- 8 Parts 4830.6510 and 4830.6520 apply to the program of state
- 9 grants for registered nurses.
- 10 4830.6510 APPLICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FOR GRANTS.
- 11 Subpart 1. Application by schools and programs. A school
- 12 or program of advanced nursing education that desires program
- 13 funds for registered nurses must submit by January 1 each year a
- 14 completed application form provided by the executive director.
- 15 Subp. 2. Modification of allocations. The executive
- 16 director shall allocate funds equal to a school or program's
- 17 estimated need for funds if the estimated need is less than the
- 18 amount determined by the allocation formula.
- 19 Subp. 3. Requirements for participant institutions. Each
- 20 participating school or advanced nursing program must also:
- 21 A. provide the executive director by the first
- 22 working day after May 31 each year with the just or nearly
- 23 completed academic year's enrollment data of registered nurses
- 24 seeking to complete baccalaureate or master's degrees in nursing
- 25 or an advanced program of nursing;
- B. establish procedures for students to apply for and
- 27 receive grants;
- C. establish criteria to use in awarding grants,
- 29 which must include consideration of the likelihood of a
- 30 student's success in completing the educational program; and
- 31 D. give priority to students:
- (1) demonstrating the greatest financial need;
- 33 and
- 34 (2) enrolling to complete baccalaureate degrees
- 35 in nursing.

- Subp. 4. Delay. A participating institution that fails to
- 2 submit the annual application for participation to the executive
- 3 director or provide requested enrollment data by its deadline
- 4 date may result in the delay of notification and disbursement by
- 5 the executive director to the institution.
- 6 Subp. 5. Accountability. Each participating school and
- 7 advanced program of nursing is accountable for any funds
- 8 disbursed to students for grants to registered nurses. Funds
- 9 may be used only during the fiscal year of disbursement. If a
- 10 student does not use a grant because the student does not enroll
- 11 or withdraws from school, the school may use the funds for other
- 12 eligible students or return the funds to the executive director.
- 13 Subp. 6. Unused funds. When requested by the executive
- 14 director, a school or advanced nursing program must report on
- 15 its use of nursing grant funds and must return unused funds.
- 16 The executive director shall reallocate unused funds to schools
- 17 or advanced nursing programs that desire additional funds.
- 18 4830.6520 REPORTS OF DATA.
- 19 Subpart 1. Annual reports. A participating school or
- 20 nursing program must collect demographic, educational, and
- 21 financial data specified by the executive director from eligible
- 22 students requesting grants, and provide the data upon request to
- 23 the executive director.
- 24 The executive director shall require end of the year
- 25 program activity and student data reports from participating
- 26 institutions. The school or advanced nursing program must
- 27 complete and submit the reports and any applicable refunds to
- 28 the executive director by the first working day after August 9.
- 29 If the reports are not completed correctly and submitted by the
- 30 deadline date, the executive director shall withhold the
- 31 subsequent year's allocation until reporting requirements are
- 32 fully met.
- 33 Subp. 2. Additional information. The executive director
- 34 or an agent may require additional information not inconsistent
- 35 with law that is helpful in the executive director's judgment to

- 1 efficiently administer the program. The additional information
- 2 may be required from grant applicants or recipients or eligible
- 3 institutions or programs.
