- 7 All costs associated with actions that do not minimize,
- 8 eliminate, or clean up a release to protect the public health
- 9 and welfare or the environment are ineligible costs. Ineligible
- 10 costs include, but are not limited to, any costs related to the
- 11 permanent repair or replacement of a tank, upgrading tanks,
- 12 removal of tanks, loss of income, attorney's fees, permanent
- 13 relocation of residents, decreased property values,
- 14 reimbursement for the responsible person's own time spent in
- 15 planning and administering a corrective action plan, aesthetic
- 16 improvements, or any work performed that is not in compliance
- 17 with safety codes including but not limited to Occupational
- 18 Safety and Health Administration requirements, well codes, and
- 19 fire codes. Other ineligible costs include corrective action
- 20 costs which are covered under an insurance or other contract for
- 21 initial and supplemental applications received by the board
- 22 after the effective date of this part.
