6 Rules as Adopted

7 6105.0330 RESTRICTED SPEED ZONES.

8 Subpart 1. **Slow speed zone.** No motorboat shall at any
9 time be operated in excess of a slow speed from the dam at
10 Taylors Falls to the sandbars located approximately at mile 31.0.

11 Subp. 2. **Slow-no wake speed.** No motorboat shall be
12 operated in excess of a slow-no wake speed in the following
13 areas:

14 A. at the narrows located approximately at mile 28.6,
15 which is 0.4 miles downstream from the Arcola high bridge;

16 B. between the Coast Guard navigational buoys
17 designating location of the navigation channel from the railroad
18 swing bridge located at approximately mile 17.3 to the south
19 side of the southernmost island in the chain of islands located
20 at approximately mile 16.5;

21 C. between the Coast Guard navigational buoys
22 designating the Kinnickinnic River delta narrows from
23 approximately mile 6.6 to approximately mile 6.0;

24 D. at the Prescott Narrows from the north side of U.S.
25 Highway No. 10 bridge located approximately at mile 0.3 to the
26 confluence of the Saint Croix River with the Mississippi River;

27 E. within 100 feet of shore (including the shores of
28 islands) and of swimmers, from sandbars located approximately at
29 mile 31.0 to the confluence of the Saint Croix River with the
30 Mississippi River;

31 F. in that area known as Andersen Bay, located
32 approximately at mile 20.0;

33 G. from shore to shore in the area known as
34 Afton-Catfish Bar, located approximately at mile 11.4 to 11.8 as
35 measured in the navigational channel, and established by

1 regulatory buoys; and

2 H. between the dam at Taylors Falls to the confluence
3 of the Saint Croix River with the Mississippi River, whenever
4 the water level reaches 683.0 feet, mean sea level, as measured
5 at the Stillwater gauge.

6 Subp. 3. **Exception.** Any motorboat designated for law
7 enforcement shall be exempt from this part in circumstances
8 involving emergencies or violation of law.
