- 5 Rules as Adopted
- 6 6100.0700 PERSONAL CONDUCT AND PROHIBITIONS.
- 7 A person's conduct shall be as prescribed in Minnesota
- 8 Statutes, section 609.72.
- 9 Without prior permission from the park manager or forest
- 10 officer, no person shall make noise tending reasonably to arouse
- 11 alarm or resentment of others by means of a public address
- 12 system, radio, stereo, amplifier, or power equipment, or by any
- 13 other means.
- 14 It is unlawful for any person in a state park, state forest
- 15 campground, or state forest day use area to consume intoxicating
- 16 liquors, or to display in public intoxicating liquor
- 17 containers. Possession of 3.2 beer in a keg is unlawful without
- 18 written permission of the park manager or forest officer.
- 19 No person shall engage in brawling or fighting, or use
- 20 offensive, obscene, or abusive language, or engage in boisterous
- 21 and noisy conduct tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger, or
- 22 resentment in others.
- 23 A person's possession and use of drugs shall be in
- 24 accordance with state laws.
- 25 6100.1610 SWIMMING AT STATE FOREST CAMPGROUNDS OR STATE FOREST
- 26 DAY USE AREAS.
- It is unlawful to swim in or enter any area where posted to
- 28 prohibit entry. It is unlawful in any area where swimming is
- 29 permitted, including designated beaches, to:
- A. allow any dog or other pet to enter the water with
- 31 swimmers;
- B. enter the water before sunrise or after sunset;
- C. engage in any activity which is hazardous and
- 34 could cause injury to others; or
- D. use any soap, detergent, or shampoo.

- In addition to items A to D, it is unlawful to possess
- 2 glass containers; to enter with any boat, canoe, or raft; fish;
- 3 or change clothes except in a facility designated for that use,
- 4 where a facility is provided.
