6 Rules as Adopted

7 3700.1420 NEW PROGRAM INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF.

8 Subpart 1. Requirements. A license may be issued in a
9 specified approved new program area, valid to teach content only
10 within that program. An individual may teach full time in an
11 authorized new program offering when the individual:

12 A. is determined to be technically and professionally
13 qualified through:

14 (1) approval and signature of the approved hiring
15 technical college administrator;

16 (2) education and/or occupational experience as
17 described in a qualifications description developed by the new
18 program advisory committee; and

19 (3) approval and signature of the chancellor of
20 the State Board of Technical Colleges;

21 B. has submitted for record with the licensing unit
22 of the State Board of Technical Colleges the approved
23 qualifications description and credentials to substantiate
24 compliance with item A; and

25 C. submits evidence of complying with the teacher
26 education course: introduction to vocational teaching.

27 Subp. 2. Duration; not renewable. A license issued under
28 this part is valid for only four years from the date it is
29 issued and is not renewable.
