6 5300.0320 CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS.

7 [For text of subpart 1, see M.R.]

8 Subp. 2. Number of hours required. Continuing education  
9 is not required during the licensee's initial licensure period,  
10 defined in part 5300.0260, subpart 2. After the initial  
11 licensure period, the licensee must complete a minimum of 30  
12 hours of continuing education every two years. Proof of  
13 completion of the required hours must be submitted to the board  
14 by December 31 of each odd-numbered year. The initial two-year  
15 period begins on January 1, 1992.

17 5300.0360 FEES.

18 The following fees in items A to K are nonrefundable and  
19 must be paid by cash or in the form of check, bank draft, or  
20 money order, made payable to the Board of Marriage and Family  
21 Therapy, Colonial Park Office Building, 2700 University Avenue  
22 West, Suite 67, Saint Paul, Minnesota 55114:

23 A. application for admission to written examination  
24 fee, \$200;

25 B. written examination fee, not to exceed \$250;

26 C. application for licensure fee, \$100;

27 D. initial license fee, not to exceed \$100;

28 E. application for licensure by reciprocity fee,  
29 \$300;

30 F. annual renewal of license fee, \$115;

31 G. late renewal fee, \$50;

32 H. reinstatement of license fee, \$150;

33 I. sponsor's application for approval of a continuing  
34 education course fee, \$50;

35 J. penalty fee, \$75; and

1           K. duplicate license fee, \$25.

2           The written examination fee in item B will be determined by  
3 the professional examination service approved by the Association  
4 for Marriage and Family Therapy Regulatory Boards administering  
5 the examination.

6           The initial license fee in item E will be prorated  
7 accordingly, depending on the month in which the applicant is  
8 approved for licensure.
