7 8850.8050 UNLOADING PETROLEUM TRANSPORT.

8 Subpart 1. [See repealer.]

9 Subp. 2. Unloading. During unloading of a petroleum  
10 transport, the driver must be within 25 feet of the cargo tank,  
11 but must not be in an enclosure or in the cab of the vehicle. A  
12 delivery hose, when attached to the cargo tank, is considered  
13 part of the cargo tank. A fire extinguisher with at least a 10  
14 B:C rating must be ready for instant use and must be at least 15  
15 feet from the cargo tank.
