9 Subp. 2. Replacement. Effective December 1, 1991, the fee
10 for the replacement of a birth certificate following adoption,
11 legitimation, adjudication of paternity, or acknowledgment of
12 paternity is \$20.

13 Subp. 3. Filing delayed registration. Effective December
14 1, 1991, the fee for the filing of a delayed registration of
15 birth or death is \$20.

16 Subp. 4. Alteration, correction, or completion. Effective
17 December 1, 1991, the fee for the alteration, correction, or
18 completion of a birth or death certificate when requested more
19 than one year after the filing of the certificate is \$20.

20 Subp. 5. Fee for verification. Effective December 1,
21 1991, the fee for the verification of information from or
22 noncertified copies of a birth, death, or marriage record is \$8
23 when the applicant furnishes specific information to locate the
24 record. When the applicant does not furnish specific
25 information the fee is \$20 per hour for staff time expended.
26 Specific information shall include the correct date of the event
27 and the correct name of the registrant.

28 Subp. 6. Copies of other documents. Effective December 1,
29 1991, the fee for issuance of a certified or noncertified copy
30 of any document on file pertaining to a vital record or a
31 certification that a document cannot be found is \$8.
