6 Rules as Adopted

7 7002.0410 SCOPE.

8 Parts 7002.0410 to 7002.0490 apply to all persons required  
9 to obtain a permit from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency  
10 under parts 7001.3050, subparts 1 and 3, item B, and 7001.3060.

11 7002.0420 DEFINITIONS.

12 Subpart 1. **Scope.** The terms defined in this part apply to  
13 parts 7002.0410 to 7002.0490. For terms not defined in this  
14 part, the definitions in part 7035.0300 apply.

15 Subp. 2. **Fiscal year.** "Fiscal year" means the year  
16 starting July 1 and ending June 30.

17 Subp. 3. On-site, one-time demolition debris land disposal  
18 facility. "On-site, one-time demolition debris land disposal  
19 facility" means a site at which a property owner disposes of  
20 demolition debris from a single process of demolition on the  
21 landowner's property.

22 Subp. 3- 4. Permit modification. "Permit modification"  
23 means a change in permit conditions that requires public comment  
24 and is subject to the procedures in parts 7001.0100 to  
25 7001.0130. A request for a minor modification as defined in  
26 part 7001.0190, subpart 3, does not require a modification fee.

27 Subp. 4- 5. Permit reissuance. "Permit reissuance" means  
28 the process by which an existing solid waste management facility  
29 permit is extended for an additional period in accordance with  
30 parts 7001.0040 to 7001.0140.

31 Subp. 5- 6. Permittee. "Permittee" means the person or  
32 persons to whom the agency has issued a solid waste management  
33 facility permit.

34 7002.0430 PERMIT FEES SCHEDULE.

1 A person subject to parts 7002.0410 to 7002.0490 shall pay  
 2 application, reissuance or modification, and annual fees based  
 3 on the schedule in this part. These fees apply to all solid  
 4 waste management facilities in operation during any part of the  
 5 fiscal year. Persons shall pay the single set of fees that  
 6 corresponds to their most costly solid waste management facility  
 7 permit.

48 \*A permittee of a mixed municipal solid waste land disposal  
 49 facility that accepts municipal solid waste combustor ash shall  
 50 pay the additional fees specified in the fee schedule.

51 7002.0440 PAYMENT OF FEES.

52 A person submitting a fee shall make the fee payable to the  
 53 "Minnesota Pollution Control Agency" and submit it to the  
 54 commissioner. All fees are nonrefundable and must be paid in  
 55 full.

## 1 7002.0450 APPLICATION FEE.

2 A person applying for a new solid waste management facility  
3 permit shall send with the application the appropriate  
4 application fee specified in part 7002.0430. An application for  
5 a new solid waste management facility permit that is submitted  
6 without the appropriate fee is incomplete. The commissioner  
7 shall delay processing the application until the appropriate fee  
8 is received.

## 9 7002.0460 REISSUANCE OR MODIFICATION FEE.

10 A permittee submitting a request for permit reissuance or  
11 permit modification of a solid waste management facility permit  
12 shall send with the request the appropriate reissuance or  
13 modification fee specified in part 7002.0430. A request for  
14 permit reissuance or permit modification that is submitted  
15 without the appropriate fee is incomplete. The commissioner  
16 shall delay processing the request until the appropriate fee is  
17 received. Failure to submit the appropriate reissuance fee with  
18 a request shall also result in the imposition of late charges  
19 specified under part 7002.0480.

## 20 7002.0470 ANNUAL FEE.

21 A permittee whose facility accepts solid waste after the  
22 effective date of this part shall pay an annual fee as specified  
23 in part 7002.0430. The first fee payment shall be made within  
24 60 days after the effective date of this part. In succeeding  
25 fiscal years, annual fees must be paid by ~~August~~ January 15.  
26 A permittee who has received a new solid waste management  
27 facility permit shall pay the appropriate annual fee within 30  
28 days ~~of~~ after receiving the permit. Failure to submit the  
29 appropriate annual fee will result in the imposition of a late  
30 charge specified under part 7002.0480.

## 31 7002.0480 LATE CHARGE.

32 The permittee shall pay a late charge of 20 percent of the  
33 payment due for failure to submit the appropriate reissuance fee  
34 or annual fee within 30 days ~~of~~ after the required date. The

1 permittee shall pay an additional ten percent of the balance  
2 owed for each 30-day period or portion of this period that the  
3 fee and late charge remain unpaid. The commissioner may begin a  
4 proceeding under part 7001.0190 to revoke the permit if the  
5 reissuance fee or annual fee is not paid by the required date.

6 7002.0490 NOTIFICATION OF ERROR.

7 A person who believes that a fee assessment or late charge  
8 is in error shall provide written evidence of the alleged error  
9 to the commissioner with the assessed fee and late charge.

10 Overpayments shall be refunded if the commissioner finds, upon  
11 reviewing the data, that the assessed fee and late charge are in  
12 error. If, upon reviewing the data, the commissioner finds that  
13 the fee or late charge was properly assessed, the commissioner  
14 shall promptly notify the person in writing. The person may  
15 seek redress before the agency in accordance with chapter 7000.
