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3 Adopted Permanent Rules Relating to Technical College Teacher

4 Licenses: Dental Assisting; Machine Tool Career

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6 Rules as Adopted

7 3700.0465 DENTAL ASSISTING.

8 Subpart 1. **May teach.** A teacher who has a dental
9 assisting instructor's license may teach in the dental assisting
10 program and may also teach courses or content which are specific
11 to dental assisting anywhere in the technical colleges.

12 Subp. 2. **Other requirements.** The applicant must meet the
13 requirements in part 3700.0100 and the requirements for a
14 teacher in the health occupational area under part 3700.0400.

15 Subp. 3. **Educational and occupational experience.** The
16 applicant must meet the requirements in items A to C.

17 A. The applicant must be a dental assistant certified
18 by the Dental Assisting National Board Inc., and registered by
19 the Minnesota Board of Dentistry, or be licensed to practice as
20 a dentist in Minnesota.

21 B. The applicant must be a graduate of an accredited
22 program by the American Dental Association's Commission on
23 Dental Accreditation in dental assisting, dental hygiene, or
24 dentistry.

25 C. The applicant must have verified occupational
26 experience and education as described in subitem (1) or (2).
27 The education must be from an accredited postsecondary
28 institution.

29 (1) A baccalaureate or above degree in health
30 science or health education and 4,000 hours of occupational
31 experience providing direct patient care which must include a
32 minimum of 2,000 hours of four-handed chairside assisting and
33 1,000 hours of legalized intra-oral dental care;

34 (2) An associate degree in a health science or
35 health education area or a certificate or diploma in dental

1 assisting and 6,000 hours of occupational experience providing
2 direct patient care and must include a minimum of 2,000 hours of
3 four-handed chairside assisting and a minimum of 1,000 hours of
4 legal intra-oral dental care.

5 **Subp. 4. Substitution for recent occupational experience.**

6 The applicant may substitute teaching experience in primary
7 program content in an accredited ADA dental hygiene or dental
8 assistant program for up to 1,500 of the 2,000 hours required in
9 part 3700.0400, provided that experience occurred within the
10 last five years. Two hours of teaching equal one hour of
11 occupational experience.

12 **3700.0850 MACHINE TOOL CAREER LICENSE.**

13 **Subpart 1. May teach.** A teacher who has a machine tool
14 career instructor license may teach in the machine tool career
15 programs and may also teach:

16 A. machine tool core; and

17 B. any course which is specific to machine tool

18 careers.

19 **Subp. 2. Other requirements.** The applicant must meet the
20 requirements in part 3700.0100 and the requirements for a
21 teacher in the trade and industrial occupational area under part
22 3700.0800.

23 **Subp. 3. Occupational experience requirement.** The
24 applicant must have 8,000 hours of verified occupational
25 experience in blueprint reading, machine set up, machine
26 troubleshooting, and machine operation of both manual and
27 computerized numerical control equipment.

28 **Subp. 4. Occupational experience substitution.** The
29 applicant may substitute the education described in item A or B
30 for up to 2,000 hours of occupational experience required in
31 subpart 3. The education must be from an accredited
32 postsecondary institution.

33 A. A bachelor's or higher degree in engineering or a
34 two-year degree, diploma, or certificate in machine tool
35 technology may be substituted for 2,000 hours; or

1 B. A one-year diploma or certificate in machine tool
2 technology may be substituted for 1,050 hours.

3 Subp. 5. Occupational recency substitution. Teaching
4 experience at an accredited postsecondary institution or
5 industrial or military setting may be substituted for 1,500 of
6 the 2,000 hours required in part 3700.0100 if the teaching is
7 done during the five years just before application for
8 licensure. The teaching must be in primary program content in
9 machine tool technology. Two hours of teaching equal one hour
10 of occupational experience.
