7 3515.1300 ALTERNATE FORMS OF OCCUPATIONAL EXPERIENCE.

9 Subp. 5. **Military experience.** Occupational experience in  
10 the military, as verified by a United States Department of  
11 Defense DD Form 214, directly related to the area of licensure  
12 sought must be accepted for the total occupational experience  
13 required for technical college licensure.

15 3700.0298 AQUACULTURE.

17 Subp. 3. **Educational and occupational experience**  
18 **requirements.** An applicant must have the requirements as listed  
19 in item A, B, or C.

21 B. An associate degree or two-year diploma or  
22 certificate from an accredited postsecondary institution in  
23 aquaculture, fisheries, fisheries and wildlife, or natural  
24 resources and 6,000 hours of occupational experience in an  
25 aquaculture, fish farm facility, or research laboratory with  
26 experience in at least five of the following:

30 3700.0420 PRACTICAL NURSING.

32 Subp. 3. **Educational and occupational experience**  
33 **requirements.** The applicant must have current Minnesota nursing  
34 registration and the experience as described in item A, B, or C.

1 The education must be from an accredited postsecondary  
2 institution. The occupational experience may be as a registered  
3 nurse or licensed practical nurse.

4 A. A bachelor's or higher degree in nursing and 4,000  
5 hours of occupational experience as a public health nurse, home  
6 health care nurse, or a nurse doing direct patient care in a  
7 hospital, skilled or intermediate nursing care facility, or in a  
8 hospice. Fifteen hundred of the hours may be in an independent  
9 clinic or a physician's office.

10 B. An associate degree in nursing and 6,000 hours of  
11 occupational experience as a public health nurse, home health  
12 nurse, or a nurse doing direct patient care in a hospital,  
13 skilled or intermediate nursing care facility, or in a hospice.  
14 Fifteen hundred of the hours may be in an independent clinic or  
15 a physician's office.

16 C. Diploma from a three-year nursing program and  
17 4,000 hours of occupational experience as a public health nurse,  
18 home health nurse, or a nurse doing direct patient care in a  
19 hospital, skilled or intermediate nursing care facility, or in a  
20 hospice. Fifteen hundred of the hours may be in an independent  
21 clinic or a physician's office.

23 3700.1410 LICENSES FOR PART-TIME CONTINUOUS OR PART-TIME GENERAL  
24 STUDIES INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL.

26 Subp. 2. **Who must be licensed.** A person holding a  
27 position as a part-time continuous program or part-time general  
28 studies instructor must be licensed according to this part if  
29 the person is not licensed for full-time instruction in the  
30 offering. A part-time continuous program or part-time general  
31 studies instructor is responsible for teaching credit-based or  
32 hour-based course content that has been identified for  
33 incorporation into an approved continuous program by a qualified  
34 full-time continuous program or general studies instructor.

35 Subp. 3. **Scope of practice.** Part-time personnel licensed

1 in this part cannot provide more than 16 quarter credits of  
2 instruction in a fiscal year.
