7 7005.5030 EXHAUST EMISSION TEST.

8 [For text of subps 1 to 9, see M.R.]

9 Subp. 10. **Reconstructed (KIT) vehicles.** All reconstructed
10 (KIT) subject vehicles shall be tested for compliance with the
11 exhaust emission standards in subpart 3, Table 1 or 2, whichever
12 is in effect, using the standards applicable to the year of
13 manufacture of the engine installed in the vehicle.

14 Subp. 11. **Exchanged engines.** For the purposes of parts
15 7005.5010 to 7005.5105, a motor vehicle with an exchanged engine
16 must be tested as described in items A to C.

17 A. Except as provided in item B, a motor vehicle must
18 be tested for compliance with the exhaust emission standards in
19 subpart 3, Table 1 or 2, whichever is in effect, using the
20 standards applicable to the model year of the vehicle's chassis.

21 B. A vehicle manufactured in model year 1991 or older
22 that has received an exchanged or rebuilt engine, or other
23 vehicle made from manufactured kit bodies (KIT cars), must be
24 tested for compliance with the exhaust emission standards in
25 subpart 3, Table 1 or 2, whichever is in effect, using the
26 standards applicable to the model year of the vehicle's chassis,
27 unless the owner of the vehicle complies with the procedure in
28 item C.

29 C. If a motor vehicle described in item B has not
30 been inspected, or if it has been inspected and failed to meet
31 the emission standards in subpart 3, Table 1 or 2, whichever is
32 in effect, using the standards applicable to the model year of
33 the vehicle's chassis, the agency representative upon request by
34 the motorist shall certify the year the engine was manufactured
35 by checking the identification number of the engine block and by

1 reviewing documentation provided by the vehicle owner. The
2 vehicle must be tested for compliance with the exhaust emission
3 standards in subpart 3, Table 1 or 2, whichever is in effect,
4 using the year of the engine as certified by the agency
5 representative. If the identification number on the block of
6 the engine is absent and the vehicle owner is unable to provide
7 documentation as to the engine year, the vehicle must be tested
8 for compliance with the exhaust emission standards for model
9 year 1976. If the agency representative determines that the
10 engine was manufactured prior to 1976, the motor vehicle is not
11 a subject vehicle.

12 Classification of a motor vehicle with an exchanged engine
13 under parts 7005.5010 to 7005.5105, and receipt of a certificate
14 of compliance or certificate of waiver for the motor vehicle
15 shall not exempt the owner of the motor vehicle from the
16 requirements of part 7005.1190 and Minnesota Statutes, section
17 325E.0951.
