- 7 Subpart 1. General. Any person engaged in the purchase,
- 8 sale, or use for any purpose other than personal consumption of
- 9 intoxicating alcoholic beverages or ethyl alcohol, shall obtain
- 10 the appropriate regulatory permit and identification card from
- 11 the commissioner as provided in this part. The fee for each
- 12 permit, other than one issued to a state or federal agency, is
- 13 \$20 and shall be submitted together with the appropriate
- 14 application form provided by the commissioner. Identification
- 15 cards and permits shall be issued for a period coinciding with
- 16 that of the appropriate state or municipal license and are not
- 17 transferable. In instances where there is no annual license
- 18 period, cards and permits shall expire one year after the date
- 19 of issuance. The authority to engage in the purchase, sale, or
- 20 use granted by the card or permit may be revoked by the
- 21 commissioner upon evidence of a violation by the holder of such
- 22 a card or permit of any of the provisions of Minnesota Statutes,
- 23 chapter 340A, or any rule of the commissioner made pursuant to
- 24 law.
