- 7 3700.0470 EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN INSTRUCTOR.
- 8 Subpart 1. May teach. A teacher who has an emergency
- 9 medical technician instructor license may teach in the emergency
- 10 medical technician program and may also teach courses specific
- 11 to emergency medical technician.
- 12 Subp. 2. Other requirements. The applicant must meet the
- 13 requirements listed in part 3700.0100 and the requirements for a
- 14 teacher in the health occupational area under part 3700.0400
- 15 unless superseded by this part.
- Subp. 3. Professional and occupational experience
- 17 requirement. The applicant must meet the experiences as
- 18 described in items A, B, and C:
- 19 A. certified by the American Heart Association as an
- 20 instructor in C.P.R. (cardiopulmonary resuscitation); and
- 21 B. verified registration/certification as described
- 22 in subitem (1), (2), or (3):
