7 7200.0650 REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE AS PSYCHOLOGICAL  
8 PRACTITIONER.

9 To be eligible for licensure as a psychological  
10 practitioner an applicant must meet the requirements of part  
11 7200.0600, items A, B, E, and F.

12 7200.1200 DENIAL OF LICENSURE.

13 An applicant who fails to meet all the requirements in  
14 parts 7200.0300 and 7200.0600 or 7200.0650 shall be denied  
15 licensure and informed in writing of the denial and the reason  
16 for it. An application submitted following denial is a new  
17 application which must be accompanied by the current licensure  
18 application fee.

19 7200.1300 EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSURE.

21 Subp. 2a. **Psychological practitioner.** The educational  
22 requirement for licensure as a psychological practitioner is the  
23 same as for licensure as a licensed psychologist by waiver as  
24 provided in subpart 2.

26 7200.3000 EXAMINATIONS.

28 Subp. 1a. **Passing scores.** The passing score for each part  
29 of the examination is the same for both levels of licensure.

30 [For text of subps 2 to 5, see M.R.]

31 7200.3400 RENEWAL DEADLINE.

32 Subpart 1. **Renewal date, information required.** The  
33 biennial renewal fee shall be remitted to the board postmarked

1 on or before the last day of the last month during which the  
2 license is valid. The renewal fee shall accompany a completed  
3 notarized renewal application including an affirmation that the  
4 statements on the renewal application are true and correct to  
5 the best knowledge and belief of the licensee.

6 Subp. 2. **Psychological practitioner requirements.** The  
7 renewal application of a psychological practitioner must include  
8 the beginning and ending dates and hours worked per month for  
9 each position held during the preceding two years, the name of  
10 the supervising licensee and number of hourly one-to-one  
11 supervisory consultation contacts per month for each position  
12 held, and verification by each supervising licensee that the  
13 supervisory consultation met the requirements of Minnesota  
14 Statutes, section 148.925, subdivision 2, paragraph (a). If the  
15 supervising licensee is deceased or otherwise not available,  
16 verification may be provided by an agency director or clinical  
17 director who has knowledge of the supervisory consultations, or  
18 by affidavit or other acceptable documentation, such as a log.

19 Subp. 3. **Content of supervisory consultation.** The  
20 supervisory consultations between the supervising licensee and  
21 the psychological practitioner who is preparing for licensure as  
22 a licensed psychologist must meet the requirements of Minnesota  
23 Statutes, section 148.925, subdivision 2, paragraph (b), and be  
24 verified as provided in subpart 2 at the time of license renewal.

25 7200.6100 FEES.

26 Fees for licensure of psychologists payable to the board  
27 are as follows:

- 28 A. application for admission to examination, \$25;
- 29 B. application for licensure, \$250;
- 30 C. renewal of license, \$250;
- 31 D. late renewal of license, \$160;
- 32 E. application for licensure as a psychological  
33 practitioner, \$180;
- 34 F. renewal of license for a psychological  
35 practitioner, \$180; and

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1           G. late renewal of license for a psychological  
2 practitioner, \$120.
