- 7 6268.0010 DEFINITIONS.
- 8 Subpart 1. Scope. For purposes of parts 6268.0010 to
- 9 6268.0040, the following terms have the meanings given them
- 10 unless otherwise provided.
- 11 Subp. 2. Commissioner. "Commissioner" means the
- 12 commissioner of natural resources.
- Subp. 3. Department. "Department" means the Minnesota
- 14 Department of Natural Resources.
- 15 Subp. 4. Experimental waters. "Experimental waters" has
- 16 the meaning given it in Minnesota Statutes, section 97C.001.
- Subp. 5. Special management waters. "Special management
- 18 waters" has the meaning given it in Minnesota Statutes, section
- 19 97C.005.
- 20 6268.0020 AUTHORITY; SCOPE; PURPOSE.
- 21 Subpart 1. Authority. Parts 6268.0010 to 6268.0040 are
- 22 adopted under authority of Minnesota Statutes, sections 97C.001
- 23 and 97C.005.
- 24 Subp. 2. Scope. Parts 6268.0010 to 6268.0040 apply to
- 25 public initiation and public participation in the evaluation of
- 26 all experimental and special management waters designations.
- Subp. 3. Purpose. The purpose of parts 6268.0010 to
- 28 6268.0040 is to ensure adequate opportunity for public
- 29 involvement in the initiation, designation, and evaluation of
- 30 experimental or special fishing regulations adopted under
- 31 Minnesota Statutes, sections 97C.001 and 97C.005.
- 32 6268.0030 PUBLIC INITIATION OF EXPERIMENTAL AND SPECIAL
- 33 MANAGEMENT WATERS DESIGNATION.
- 34 Subpart 1. Submission of proposals. A person,

- 1 organization, or other entity may submit a proposal to the
- 2 commissioner at any time for designation of specific lakes or
- 3 streams as experimental or special management waters. Proposals
- 4 must include the following information:
- 5 A. names of waters proposed for designation and
- 6 counties where waters are located;
- 7 B. description of proposed experimental or special
- 8 regulations;
- 9 C. objective of proposed experimental or special
- 10 regulations;
- D. documentation of public support for the proposal;
- 12 and
- E. proposed implementation date.
- 14 Subp. 2. Proposal evaluation. The commissioner shall
- 15 evaluate proposals for experimental or special management waters
- 16 based on the following criteria:
- A. presence of an objective which meets a defined
- 18 biological or social need supported by reliable information;
- B. compatibility with existing programs of the
- 20 department;
- 21 C. public acceptance;
- D. compatibility with existing state law;
- 23 E. availability of sufficient funding if needed for
- 24 evaluation; and
- 25 F. scientific validity and conformance with
- 26 established biological principles.
- 27 Subp. 3. Action on proposal. The commissioner may deny a
- 28 proposal which does not meet the criteria in subpart 2, or may
- 29 suggest modifications to the proposal so that it better meets
- 30 the criteria. The commissioner shall notify originators of
- 31 proposals of acceptance, denial, or suggested modifications
- 32 within three months of receiving the proposal. The commissioner
- 33 shall provide a written explanation for denials and suggestions
- 34 for modification. The originator of the proposal may decide to
- 35 accept suggested modifications or to drop the proposal.
- 36 Acceptance of a proposal by the commissioner is not a guarantee

- 1 that the proposal will be implemented as experimental or special
- 2 management waters.
- 3 Subp. 4. Proposal approval. Proposals which are accepted
- 4 by the commissioner are subject to further review by the
- 5 department; public notice and meeting requirements of Minnesota
- 6 Statutes, sections 97C.001, subdivision 2, and 97C.005,
- 7 subdivision 1; and all other applicable state law before final
- 8 approval and implementation. The commissioner may order that a
- 9 proposal be dropped or modified at any time during the internal
- 10 review or public notification process. If a proposal is dropped
- ll or modified, the commissioner shall provide the reasons for this
- 12 action in writing to the originator of the proposal. The
- 13 originator of the proposal may decide to accept the
- 14 commissioner's modifications or to drop the proposal.
- 15 6268.0040 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN EVALUATION OF EXPERIMENTAL AND
- 16 SPECIAL MANAGEMENT WATERS DESIGNATION.
- 17 Subpart 1. Experimental waters. Public meetings held to
- 18 determine if experimental waters should be terminated, extended,
- 19 or designated as special management waters must provide an
- 20 opportunity for public review, comment, and questions concerning
- 21 the proposed action. The commissioner shall review public
- 22 comments before making a final determination on whether
- 23 experimental waters should be terminated, extended, or
- 24 designated as special management waters. Final determination
- 25 regarding changes in experimental waters designation will
- 26 consider public comments, but will also be based on natural
- 27 resource needs and department management plans.
- Subp. 2. Special management waters. The commissioner may
- 29 hold meetings to allow public review, comment, and questions
- 30 concerning existing special management waters. The commissioner
- 31 shall review public comments before making a determination on
- 32 changing the status of special management waters. Final
- 33 determination regarding changes in special management waters
- 34 designation will consider public comments, but will also be
- 35 based on natural resource needs and department management plans.
