6 Rules as Adopted

7 5224.0010 PURPOSE.

8 The purpose of this chapter is to establish standards for 9 distinguishing between an employee and an independent contractor for purposes of workers' compensation coverage under Minnesota 10 Statutes, sections 176.021 and 176.041. For those occupations 11 specifically discussed in parts 5224.0020 to 5224.0312, this 12 13 chapter establishes a "safe harbor" for assuring either independent contractor or employee status in those occupations. 14 15 Where a worker is within the scope of the definition of a part, but does not meet the safe harbor criteria for either 16 independent contractor or employee status, the determination 17 18 shall be made as described in part 5224.0320.

19 "Employee" as used in this chapter means a worker who is 20 not an independent contractor. The employee safe harbor 21 criteria are not intended to define "employee" under Minnesota 22 Statutes, section 176.011, subdivision 9, for any purpose other 23 than distinguishing workers who are not independent contractors.
