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3 Adopted Permanent Rules Relating to Out-of-State Providers

6 9505.0215 COVERED SERVICES; OUT-OF-STATE PROVIDERS.

7 A health service provided to a recipient by an out-of-state
8 provider is eligible for medical assistance payment if the
9 service meets the requirements of items A, B, and C. For
10 purposes of this part, "out-of-state provider" means a provider
11 who is located outside of Minnesota and outside of the
12 recipient's local trade area.

13 A. The service must be a covered service as defined
14 in part 9505.0175, subpart 6.

15 B. The provider must obtain prior authorization if
16 prior authorization is required under Minnesota Statutes,
17 section 256B.0625, subdivision 25, parts 9505.0170 to 9505.0475,
18 or parts 9505.5000 to 9505.5030.

19 C. The service must meet one of the following
20 conditions:

21 (1) the department determines, on the basis of
22 medical advice from a consultant as defined in part 9505.5005,
23 subpart 3, that the service is not available in Minnesota or the
24 recipient's local trade area;

25 (2) the service is in response to an emergency;

26 or

27 (3) the service is needed because the recipient's
28 health would be endangered if the recipient was required to
29 return to Minnesota.
