- 7 7856.2020 SELECTION OF RETAILERS.
- 8 Subpart 1. Eligibility. An applicant for a lottery
- 9 retailer contract must:

- 11 E. not have an officer, director, or person who owns
- 12 more than five percent of the business of the applicant who has
- 13 within the previous five years been convicted of a felony, gross
- 14 misdemeanor, or crime involving fraud or misrepresentation, or a
- 15 gambling-related offense except as provided under Minnesota
- 16 Statutes, section 349A.06, subdivision 2, clause (c); and
- 17 F. not be a member of the immediate family residing
- 18 in the same household as the director, board member, or employee
- 19 of the lottery.

- 21 7857.6000 PRIZES PAYABLE AFTER DEATH OF PRIZE WINNER.
- 22 Subpart 1. General. All prizes or portions of prizes due
- 23 will remain payable at the time of death of the prize winner.
- 24 Upon payment as provided under this chapter, the lottery will be
- 25 absolved of any further liability. The payment of a prize may
- 26 not be accelerated before the normal date of tender or payment
- 27 because of the death of the prize winner or for any reason,
- 28 except as provided in subpart 4.

- 30 Subp. 4. Acceleration of payment. After the death of a
- 31 lottery prize winner and upon petition of the estate of the
- 32 lottery prize winner, the director may accelerate payment of all
- 33 remaining proceeds from the winning ticket to the estate of the
- 34 lottery winner by either:
- 35 A. transferring to the estate all securities and

- 1 other investment securities held by the lottery to satisfy the
- 2 prize requirements; or
- 3 B. paying the estate the present value of the
- 4 remaining payments of the lottery winner's prize.
- 5 7858.0100 PRIZE DRAWING PROCEDURES.
- 6 Subpart 1. Retailer notification. In any instant ticket
- 7 lottery game conducted by the lottery in which purchased tickets
- 8 may be mailed to the lottery for entry in one or more prize
- 9 drawings, the lottery will notify all lottery retailers selling
- 10 tickets in the game to cease selling tickets for that game at
- ll least seven days before the date the tickets must be received by
- 12 the lottery to be eligible for entry in the final prize drawing.
- 13 Subp. 2. Player notification. For any instant ticket
- 14 lottery game conducted by the lottery where tickets may be
- 15 mailed to the lottery for entry in one or more prize drawings,
- 16 the lottery game information for notice to players supplied to
- 17 lottery retailers by the lottery must state the date by which
- 18 tickets must be received by the lottery to be eligible for entry
- 19 in the final prize drawing.
- Subp. 3. Game procedures and player brochures; required
- 21 information. All instant ticket game procedures adopted by the
- 22 lottery, and the player brochures for any instant game where
- 23 tickets may be mailed to the lottery for entry into one or more
- 24 prize drawings, must state the date by which tickets must be
- 25 received by the lottery to be eligible for entry in the final
- 26 prize drawing. That date must be from seven to 30 days after
- 27 the date on which lottery retailers are to cease selling tickets
- 28 for that game.
- 29 7858.0200 STATEMENT OF ODDS.
- In any instant ticket lottery game conducted by the lottery
- 31 in which a noncash prize may be awarded and the odds are stated
- 32 on the back of the ticket, the statement of odds on the ticket
- 33 must provide a statement of:
- 34 A. the odds of winning a cash prize expressly
- 35 indicating that the odds are those for winning a cash prize;

- B. the overall odds of winning a cash prize or a
- 2 noncash prize associated with the game and a statement expressly
- 3 indicating that those are the odds stated for winning a cash or
- 4 noncash prize; or
- 5 C. the odds of winning a cash prize and a statement
- 6 of the overall odds of winning a prize associated with the game,
- 7 expressly indicating that the odds are those for winning a cash
- 8 prize, and expressly indicating the overall odds of winning a
- 9 prize.
