7 5230.0100 FEES.

9 Subp. 2. Application for renewal. A license that has  
10 expired within one year of application for renewal may be  
11 renewed without an examination on filing an application for  
12 renewal with the department, accompanied by the fee required in  
13 this part. An application for renewal received by the  
14 department more than 30 days after the expiration date of the  
15 license must be accompanied by the late fee in subpart 3, item F.

16 If a license holder has failed to submit an application for  
17 renewal within one year of the date of the expiration of the  
18 license, renewal is not allowed unless the applicant files the  
19 application, pays the fee required by this part, and passes the  
20 examination required by this chapter.

21 Subp. 3. Examination and license. The fees for  
22 examination and license are as follows:

- 23 A. pipefitter journeyman, examination and license,  
24 \$100;
- 25 B. renewal of pipefitter journeyman license, \$60;
- 26 C. contracting pipefitter, examination and license,  
27 \$250;
- 28 D. renewal of contracting pipefitter license, \$220;
- 29 E. pipefitter contractor bond and insurance  
30 processing, \$100; and
- 31 F. late fees:
- 32 (1) contractor, \$250; and  
33 (2) journeyman, \$100.

34 Payment of examination and license fees must accompany the  
35 application. There will be no refund of fees paid.
