7 4625.2300 INITIAL AND RENEWAL LICENSE FEES, LICENSE EXPIRATION

9 Subpart 1. **Fee schedule.** License applications for lodging
10 establishments as defined in part 4625.0100 must be accompanied
11 by a fee of \$75 plus \$4 per room, up to a maximum total fee of
12 \$475.

14 4625.5000 INITIAL AND RENEWAL LICENSE FEES, LICENSE EXPIRATION

15 DATES.

16 Subpart 1. **Fee schedule.** Initial and renewal license
17 applications for food and beverage establishments as defined in
18 part 4625.2401 must be accompanied by the applicable fee as
19 determined from items A to G. The average number of employees
20 must be computed in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section
21 157.03:

22 A. one to four employees, \$106;

23 B. five to ten, \$175;

24 C. 11 to 20, \$245;


25 D. 21 to 30, \$295;

26 E. 31 to 40, \$365;

27 F. 41 and over, \$430; and

28 G. limited food or beverage establishments that sell
29 only prepackaged foods that receive heat treatment and are
30 served in the package, mobile units, or itinerant and special
31 event stands serving food or beverages for 14 days or less in
32 any single location, \$106.

33 Subp. 1a. **Construction; remodeling.** An initial license
34 application for food and beverage establishments as defined in
35 part 4625.2401 must be accompanied by a fee of \$150 for review

1 of the construction or remodeling plans as required under part
2 4625.2701. When an establishment is extensively remodeled, a
3 fee of \$150 must accompany the remodeling plans required under
4 part 4625.2701. Neither an initial license plan review fee nor
5 a remodeling plan review fee shall be required for a limited
6 food service establishment as defined in part 4625.2401, subpart
7 22, that is not a mobile food service as defined in part
8 4625.2401, subpart 23. Extensive remodeling means an addition
9 or change to the physical facility, or making a major equipment
10 addition. Extensive remodeling does not include redecorating,
11 cosmetic refurbishing, or altering seating design or capacity.
