6 Rules as Adopted

7 3700.1200 GENERAL STUDIES.

8 Subpart 1. ~~Listed-here~~ License requirements. An applicant
9 for a license in general studies must meet the requirements in
10 this part. These requirements are in addition to the
11 requirements listed in part 3700.0100 and for a particular
12 license.

13 Subp. 2. ~~Do-not-apply~~ Rules not applicable. The
14 requirements in parts 3515.0100, subpart 25; 3515.1200;
15 3515.1300; 3515.4100; 3515.4200; 3515.4300; 3515.4400;
16 3515.6005, subpart 1; 3515.9920; and 3515.9941 do not apply to
17 applicants for licensure in general studies. Part 3700.9942 no
18 longer applies to part 3700.1280.

19 Subp. 3. Occupational experience. The applicant must
20 verify one of the following experiences in items A to E:

21 A. three quarter credits in applied occupational
22 concepts;

23 B. 500 hours in the five years preceding application
24 of occupational experience in one of the seven technical college
25 program areas;

26 C. 40 clock hours of participation verified by an
27 authorized technical college administrator in a any combination
28 of ~~all-of~~ the following:

29 (1) ex officio occupational advisory committees;

30 (2) business/industrial site visits; and

31 (3) occupational program classroom/laboratory
32 observation;

33 D. currently licensed as an instructor in an
34 occupational program area; or

35 E. completion of an approved internship sponsored by

1 the State Board of Technical Colleges.

2 3700.1210 GENERAL STUDIES, APPLIED MATH.

3 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
4 a license in general studies/applied math may teach applied and
5 developmental math.

6 Subp. 2. **Other requirements**. The applicant must meet the
7 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the
8 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
9 3700.1200.

10 Subp. 3. **Educational requirements**. The educational
11 requirements are:

12 A. a bachelor's degree or above with a major in math;
13 or

14 B. a bachelor's degree or above with a major in
15 science and 45 quarter credits in math.

16 3700.1220 GENERAL STUDIES, APPLIED COMMUNICATIONS.

17 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
18 a license in general studies/applied communications may teach
19 applied communications.

20 Subp. 2. **Other requirements**. The applicant must meet the
21 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the
22 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
23 3700.1200.

24 Subp. 3. **Educational requirements**. The educational
25 requirements are a bachelor's degree or above with a major in
26 one of the following:

27 A. English;

28 B. communications; or

29 C. speech.

30 3700.1230 GENERAL STUDIES, APPLIED PHYSICS.

31 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
32 a license in general studies/applied physics may teach applied
33 physics.

34 Subp. 2. **Other requirements**. The applicant must meet the

1 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the
2 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
3 3700.1200.

4 Subp. 3. Educational requirements. The educational
5 requirements are a bachelor's degree or above with a major in
6 physics.

7 3700.1240 GENERAL STUDIES, APPLIED CHEMISTRY.

8 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
9 a license in general studies/applied chemistry may teach applied
10 chemistry.

11 Subp. 2. Other requirements. The applicant must meet the
12 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the
13 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
14 3700.1200.

15 Subp. 3. Educational requirements. The educational
16 requirements are a bachelor's degree or above with a major in
17 chemistry.

18 3700.1250 GENERAL STUDIES, APPLIED ANATOMY/PHYSIOLOGY.

19 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
20 a license in general studies/applied anatomy/physiology may
21 teach applied anatomy/physiology.

22 Subp. 2. Other requirements. The applicant must meet the
23 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the
24 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
25 3700.1200.

26 Subp. 3. Educational requirements. The educational
27 requirements are a bachelor's degree or above with a major in
28 health science.

29 3700.1260 GENERAL STUDIES, FIRST AID INSTRUCTOR

30 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
31 a technical college first aid instructor license may teach first
32 aid.

33 Subp. 2. Other requirements. The applicant must meet the
34 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the

1 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
2 3700.1200.

3 Subp. 3. Does not apply. Part 3515.1400, items A, C, and
4 D do not apply.

5 Subp. 4. Educational requirements. An applicant must be
6 certified as an instructor, instructor trainer, or auxiliary
7 faculty by one of the following:

- 8 A. American Red Cross; or
- 9 B. National Safety Council.

10 3700.1265 GENERAL STUDIES, CARDIO-PULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR)
11 INSTRUCTOR.

12 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
13 a technical college cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
14 instructor license may teach CPR.

15 Subp. 2. Other requirements. The applicant must meet the
16 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the
17 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
18 3700.1200.

19 Subp. 3. Does not apply. Part 3515.1400, items A, C, and
20 D do not apply.

21 Subp. 4. Educational requirements. An applicant must be
22 certified as an instructor, instructor trainer, or auxiliary
23 faculty in CPR by one of the following:

- 24 A. American Heart Association;
- 25 B. American Red Cross; or
- 26 C. National Safety Council.

27 3700.1270 GENERAL STUDIES, DEVELOPMENTAL MATH.

28 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
29 a license in general studies/developmental math may teach
30 developmental math.

31 Subp. 2. Other requirements. The applicant must meet the
32 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the
33 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
34 3700.1200.

35 Subp. 3. Educational requirements. The applicant must



1 meet the requirements listed in items A and B:

2 A. a bachelor's degree or above with a minimum of 15
3 quarter credits in math; and

4 B. 1,000 hours of experience teaching remedial math
5 classes or six quarter credits in remedial teaching methods with
6 at least three of the credits in remedial math methods.

7 3700.1275 GENERAL STUDIES, DEVELOPMENTAL READING.

8 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
9 a license in general studies/developmental reading may teach
10 developmental reading.

11 Subp. 2. **Other requirements**. The applicant must meet the
12 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the
13 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
14 3700.1200.

15 Subp. 3. **Educational requirements**. The applicant must
16 meet the requirements listed in items A and B:

17 A. a bachelor's degree or above with a major in
18 elementary education or special education/learning disabilities
19 or a bachelor's degree or above with a minimum of 15 quarter
20 credits in reading; and

21 B. 1,000 hours of experience teaching remedial
22 reading classes or six quarter credits in remedial teaching
23 methods with at least three of the credits in remedial reading
24 methods.

25 3700.1280 GENERAL STUDIES, OCCUPATIONAL ENGLISH AS A SECOND
26 LANGUAGE.

27 Subpart 1. **May-teach Eligible teacher**. A teacher who has
28 a license in general studies/English as a second language may
29 teach English as a second language.

30 Subp. 2. **Other requirements**. The applicant must meet the
31 requirements for a teacher in part 3700.0100 and the
32 requirements for a teacher in general studies under part
33 3700.1200.

34 Subp. 3. **Educational requirements**. The applicant must
35 meet the requirements listed in items A and B:

1 A. a bachelor's degree or above with a minimum of 15
2 quarter credits in:

- 3 (1) English;
- 4 (2) reading;
- 5 (3) linguistics;
- 6 (4) communications; or
- 7 (5) speech; and

8 B. 1,000 hours of experience teaching English as a
9 second language classes or six quarter credits in remedial
10 teaching methods with at least three of the credits in teaching
11 English as a second language.

12 3700.1281 APPLICATION.

13 Subpart 1. Conversion of existing bilingual instructors
14 licenses. Individuals licensed according to part 3515.9941,
15 bilingual, bicultural remedial-related reading instructor will
16 convert to part 3700.1275, general studies/developmental
17 reading. Individuals licensed according to part 3515.9941,
18 bilingual, bicultural postsecondary remedial-related math
19 instructor may convert to part 3700.1270, general
20 studies/developmental math. An applicant may retain and renew
21 either preconversion license.

22 Subp. 2. Conversion of existing related instructors
23 licenses. On the effective date of parts 3700.1200 to
24 3700.1280, the state board shall convert the existing license
25 issued under part 3515.6005, 3515.9921, 3515.9941, or 3515.9942
26 listed in column A to the license listed in column B. At the
27 licensee's next renewal date the renewed license must show the
28 new license title.
