6 7045.0020 DEFINITIONS.

8 Subp. 15. Designated facility. "Designated facility"

9 means a hazardous waste treatment, storage, or disposal facility
10 which:

18 interface material" means off-specification fuel created by the
19 mixing of fuel products of different specifications in a
20 pipeline during transportation.

22 7045.0120 EXEMPTIONS AND SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS.

24 Subp. 2. Special requirements. The following waste is
25 exempt from the general requirements of this chapter if managed
26 as specified:

31 generators under part 7045.0320; and

34 7045.0125 MANAGEMENT OF WASTE BY USE, REUSE, RECYCLING, AND

1 RECLAMATION.

3 Subp. 4. Management of specific hazardous wastes.

4 Management of the following wastes when recycled, is not subject
5 to regulation under parts 7045.0205 to 7045.0695 and 7045.1300
6 to 7045.1380:

8 I. oil that is reclaimed from oil-bearing hazardous
9 wastes from petroleum refining, production, and transportation
10 practices, and is burned as a fuel without reintroduction to a
11 refining process, if the reclaimed oil meets the used oil fuel
12 specification under part 7045.0695, subpart 1, item B, subitem
13 (1);14 J. petroleum coke produced from petroleum refinery
15 hazardous wastes containing oil at the same facility at which
16 the wastes were generated, unless the resulting coke product
17 exhibits one or more of the characteristics of hazardous waste
18 in part 7045.0131; and19 K. pipeline interface material, provided that the
20 material is transported solely in a pipeline system as defined
21 in Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, part 195, and is sent
22 to a refinery for use as an ingredient in a refining process or
23 to a facility for reclamation.24 Subp. 5. Requirements for use of hazardous waste as
25 feedstock.

27 B. A generator of hazardous waste for use as
28 feedstock is subject to the following generator requirements:

2 A. A by-product or a sludge that is hazardous only
3 because it exhibits a characteristic of hazardous waste as
4 defined in part 7045.0131 and is reclaimed is subject to only
5 the following requirements:

9 7045.0230 CONTENT OF LICENSE APPLICATION.

10 Subpart 1. Information required. Except as provided in
11 subpart 1a, an application must be on a form provided by the
12 commissioner and must include the following information:
