8 4812.0160 PARTICIPANT RESPONSIBILITIES.

9 Subpart 1. Service status verification. Semiannually, the  
10 participant must complete and return to the executive director  
11 by the deadline the service status verification form provided by  
12 the executive director. The program participant shall receive  
13 the service status verification form six months from the date of  
14 entrance into the program, and every six months thereafter. The  
15 participant has 30 days from the date of receipt of the form to  
16 complete and return it to the executive director.

18 4830.0700 METHOD OF PAYMENT.

20 Subp. 2. Refunds. A grant is awarded for full-time  
21 attendance at a specified school for the academic year of nine  
22 months within the state fiscal year. If a recipient fails to  
23 enroll or reduces enrollment, the school must refund the unused  
24 portion of the award. If the executive director determines that  
25 a school has fraudulently handled grant money, the refund of the  
26 unused portion of the award is immediately due, and the board  
27 may institute a civil action for recovery if necessary. Refunds  
28 to the board are determined as follows:

29 A. calculate the percentage the state grant award  
30 represents of the student's total financial aid package for the  
31 applicable term, excluding funds received from federal Title IV  
32 programs, United States Code, title 20, sections 1070-1099;

33 B. calculate the total tuition refund amount using  
34 the institution's refund policy or the federal pro rata refund  
35 calculation;

1           C. subtract the federal aid programs' refund amount  
2 from item B to determine the remaining tuition refund amount;  
3 and

4           D. multiply the percentage in item A by the amount  
5 calculated in item C to determine the amount to be refunded to  
6 the state grant program.

7           Refunded money to the state grant program is available for  
8 awards to eligible students.
