- 7 Subpart 1. Fee. On or before January 1 of each year, the
- 8 board shall receive a license renewal fee of \$105 from every
- 9 licensed optometrist who desires to continue to be entitled to
- 10 practice in this state.

- 12 Subp. 4. Default; revocation of license. When an
- 13 optometrist defaults in payment of the annual renewal fee under
- 14 subpart 1, the board may invoke the procedures of part 6500.2800
- 15 for the revocation of the license; provided that the payment of
- 16 the fee at or before the completion of the procedures of part
- 17 6500.2800, with such additional sum not exceeding \$35 as may be
- 18 fixed by the board, shall excuse the default. In the event any
- 19 default remains unexcused at the completion of the procedures of
- 20 part 6500.2800 and a license is revoked for nonpayment of
- 21 renewal fees, the board may, in its discretion, refuse to issue
- 22 a new license to any person whose license has been so revoked
- 23 until such time as that person repasses or, if previously
- 24 licensed by reciprocity, passes the examinations and complies
- 25 with all other requirements for initial licensure by examination
- 26 in this state.
