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6 Rules as Adopted

7 7414.1400 PERIODIC REEXAMINATION.

8 Each school bus driver is required to take and pass a  
9 physical examination every two years in order to retain the  
10 school bus driver's endorsement. The two-year reexamination  
11 period will start from the examination date of the most recent  
12 physical examination certificate submitted by a school bus  
13 driver. The Department of Public Safety will send physical  
14 examination certificates to school bus drivers. A school bus  
15 driver shall return the certificate, completed by the examining  
16 physician, along with a \$2 processing fee, on or before the  
17 expiration of the two-year period, to the Department of Public  
18 Safety. Failure to pass and return the physical examination  
19 will result in cancellation of the school bus driver's  
20 endorsement from the Minnesota driver license.

21 7414.1600 USE OF FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER MEDICAL EXAMINATION  
22 CERTIFICATE.

23 Subpart 1. Exemption. An applicant for an initial school  
24 bus driver's endorsement or for renewal of a school bus driver's  
25 endorsement is exempt from parts 7414.1100, 7414.1200,  
26 7414.1300, and 7414.1400, upon providing evidence of being  
27 medically examined and certified within the preceding 24 months  
28 as physically qualified to operate a commercial motor vehicle,  
29 pursuant to Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, part 391,  
30 subpart E, or ~~rules-of-the-commissioner-of-transportation~~  
31 Minnesota Statutes, section 221.0314, incorporating those  
32 federal regulations. As evidence of being medically examined  
33 and certified, the applicant is required to submit, to the  
34 Department of Public Safety, the original or photographic copy  
35 of the commercial motor carrier physical examination form or the

1 medical examiner's certificate under those federal regulations.

2 Subp. 2. Periodic reexamination. Each school bus driver  
3 is required to take and pass a physical examination every two  
4 years in order to retain the school bus driver's endorsement.

5 The two-year reexamination period will start from the  
6 examination date of the most recent physical examination form or  
7 medical examiner's certificate submitted by a school bus driver  
8 under subpart 1. A school bus driver must send the original or  
9 photographic copy of the completed physical examination form or  
10 medical examiner's certificate, along with a \$2 processing fee,  
11 on or before the expiration of the two-year period, to the  
12 Department of Public Safety. Failure to pass the physical  
13 examination and submit the physical examination form or medical  
14 examiner's certificate will result in cancellation of the school  
15 bus driver's endorsement from the Minnesota driver's license.
