- 7 7417.0100 PURPOSE AND SCOPE.
- 8 Subpart 1. Purpose. The purpose of parts 7417.0100 to
- 9 7417.0400 is to establish the design of a uniform dangerous dog
- 10 tag, to be inscribed on or attached to each dangerous dog's tag
- 11 and affixed to each dangerous dog's collar at all times.
- 12 Subp. 2. Scope. The scope of parts 7417.0100 to 7417.0400
- 13 is to be consistent with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes,
- 14 section 347.51, subdivision 7.
- 15 7417.0200 UNIFORM DANGEROUS DOG TAG.
- 16 Subpart 1. Description. Each uniform dangerous dog tag
- 17 must meet the following standards:
- 18 A. It must be circular in shape and 1-1/2 inches in
- 19 diameter.
- 20 B. A ring one-fourth inch in diameter must be affixed
- 21 to the top center of the dangerous dog tag, so that the
- 22 dangerous dog tag can be affixed to the dangerous dog's collar.
- 23 C. The outer edges of the circle must contain a
- 24 perfect red circle that is one-fourth inch in width.
- D. An illustration of a black dog must be shown in
- 26 the center of the circle standing on its hind legs at a
- 27 45-degree angle, with its open mouth facing the right side of
- 28 the symbol.
- 29 E. The dog must appear to be in the process of
- 30 attempting to bite at a black hand and wrist that is entering
- 31 the circle from the right side and is pointed toward the dog's
- 32 open mouth.
- F. The hand and wrist must also protrude into the
- 34 circle one-fourth inch, with a one-sixteenth inch yellow space
- 35 between the end of the wrist and the inner edge of the red

- l circle.
- 2 G. The dog must also be proportionately centered in
- 3 the circle and be one inch long, from the dog's extreme hind leg
- 4 to the front tip of the dog's nose.
- 5 H. The hand and wrist must enter into the inside of
- 6 the circle, from the right side, one-fourth inch.
- 7 I. The hand must also have all five fingers spread
- 8 apart, with the palm of the hand showing.
- 9 J. The remaining portion of the tag must be bright
- 10 yellow.
- 11 Subp. 2. Construction, registration number, inscription.
- 12 The uniform dangerous dog tag must be made of one-sixteenth inch
- 13 thick aluminum and shall have the dangerous dog's registration
- 14 number inscribed on the back of the tag. Each uniform dangerous
- 15 dog tag must also have the following words inscribed on or
- 16 attached to the back:
- 17 "Minnesota Statutes, section 347.51, requires that
- 18 this authorized warning symbol be posted on a
- 19 dangerous dog tag and affixed to the dog's collar at
- 20 all times. Minnesota Department of Public Safety"
- 21 7417.0300 TAG WORN BY EACH DANGEROUS DOG.
- 22 Subpart 1. Requirement. Each dangerous dog registered
- 23 under Minnesota Statutes, section 347.51, must have a uniform
- 24 dangerous dog tag affixed to the dangerous dog's collar at all
- 25 times.
- 26 Subp. 2. Separate tag. The uniform dangerous dog tag
- 27 shall be a dog tag separate and apart from the dog tag that dogs
- 28 are required to wear under part 1720.1555.
