6 7035.2845 RECYCLING FACILITIES.

Subpart 1. Scope. The owner or operator of a recycling
facility must comply with subparts 2 to 6.

9 Subp. 2. Notification. The owner or operator of a recycling facility shall submit a notification form to the 10 commissioner on a form prescribed by the commissioner prior to 11 12 beginning facility operations. The owner or operator shall notify the commissioner no later than 30 days after the 13 effective date when the owner or operator relocates the 14 facility. The owner or operator shall notify the commissioner 15 16 at least 30 days before the effective date when ceasing 17 operations.

Subp. 3. Design requirements. The owner or operator of a 18 19 recycling facility shall design and construct the facility to 20 prevent surface water drainage through recyclable and residual materials, to control dispersion of the recyclable materials and 21 residuals by wind, to contain any spills or releases that could 22 23 harm human health or the environment, to provide for the storage 24 of recyclable materials so as to protect the recyclability of the materials, and to provide for the storage and removal of 25 residuals. Storage of waste on-site must comply with part 26 7035.2855. 27

Subp. 4. Operation. The owner or operator of a recycling facility shall effectively control dust, windblown material, vermin populations, and other nuisance conditions at the facility and shall remove all putrescible materials at least once a week. All other residuals must be removed at least once a month.

34 Subp. 4a. Annual report. By February March 1 of each 35 year, the owner or operator of a recycling facility shall submit

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1 an annual report to the commissioner, on a form prescribed by the commissioner, indicating the name and address of the 2 recycling facility, the year covered by the report, the type and 3 volume weight of materials handled at the facility; and the 4 distribution of materials by volume weight, i.e., what volume 5 weight of recyclable material received went to an end market, a 6 broker/processor, or was managed as mixed municipal solid waste. 7 8 Subp. 4b. Storage. All of the recyclable materials that are delivered to or are stored at the recycling facility must be 9 removed from the facility within one-year three years after the 10 date of receipt. The owner or operator must notify the 11 commissioner annually, in the annual report required in subpart 12 13 4a, if recyclable materials are stored longer than one year. 14 The annual report must identify the type and approximate weight of material being stored. Recyclable materials that are stored 15 16 longer than one year must be stored in such a way that the recyclability is retained. 17

18 Subp. 4c. Inspections. The owner or operator of a 19 recycling facility must inspect the facility, at least every 30 20 days, for malfunctions, deterioration, or discharges that may result in either the release of pollutants to the environment or 21 a threat to human health. The owner or operator must develop 22 and follow a written schedule for inspecting monitoring 23 equipment, safety and emergency equipment, security devices, and 24 25 operating and structural equipment used to prevent, detect, or respond to environmental or human health hazards. The owner or 26 27 operator must retain at the facility a copy of the schedule which must identify the types of problems to look for during the 28 29 inspection. The owner or operator must remedy any deterioration or malfunction of equipment or structure no later than two weeks 30 31 after an inspection. If the owner or operator is unable to 32 remedy the deterioration or malfunction within two weeks due to the nature of the problem, availability of materials, or other 33 34 factors that influence repair efforts, the owner or operator must remedy the problem as soon as possible and must keep a 35 current summary report of the incident and the steps being taken 36

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1 to remedy the situation.

2 Subp. 4d. Operating record. The owner or operator of a recycling facility must keep a written operating record at the 3 facility until April 1 of each year for the preceding calendar 4 The owner or operator must record the type and volume 5 year. weight of recyclable materials received for each day,-the-date 6 7 received, quarter and their distribution by volume weight. The operating record must also include summary reports and details 8 9 of incidents that require implementing the contingency action plan specified in subpart 5, and records and results of 10 11 inspections required by subpart 4c.

12 Subp. 5. Contingency action plan. The owner or operator 13 of a recycling facility shall prepare and maintain a contingency 14 action plan for the recycling facility. The plan must address 15 what actions the owner or operator will take if a fire, spill, 16 or release occurs at the facility and what backup system exists 17 if the owner of operator closes the facility for any period of 18 time.

Subp. 6. Closure. At least 30 days prior to the effective 19 date of closure, the owner or operator of a recycling facility 20 21 must post a notice of closure at the entrance by signs indicating the date of closure, and must publish a notice of 22 closure in a local newspaper. No later than 30 days after 23 ceasing operations, the owner or operator of a recycling 24 25 facility must properly remove and treat or dispose of all waste and contaminated soil or structures at the facility. 26

27 7035.2585 ANNUAL REPORT.

The owner or operator of a solid waste management facility shall prepare and submit a single copy of an annual report to the commissioner no later than February 1 for the preceding calendar year. A report form and instructions may be obtained from the commissioner. The annual report must cover all facility activities during the previous calendar year and must include the following information:
