- 7 4830.9015 APPLICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FOR GRANTS.
- 8 Subpart 1. Application by schools and programs. A school,
- 9 or educational program of registered nursing or advanced nursing
- 10 must submit each year to the director a completed participation
- 11 application form provided by the director.
- 12 Subp. 2. Responsibility. Each participating school, or
- 13 educational program of registered nursing or advanced nursing
- 14 must:
- A. when requested by the director, provide enrollment
- 16 data of students enrolled in registered nursing or advanced
- 17 nursing education programs;
- B. establish procedures for students to apply for and
- 19 receive grants;
- 20 C. establish criteria to use in awarding grants to
- 21 nursing students, which must include the likelihood of the
- 22 student's success in completing the nursing educational program;
- D. give priority to students with the greatest
- 24 financial need; and
- 25 E. agree that the money awarded through the grant
- 26 program must not be used to replace any other grant or
- 27 scholarship money for which the student would be otherwise
- 28 eligible.
- 29 Subp. 3. Allocation formula. Funds shall be allocated to
- 30 each school or nursing program according to the following
- 31 formula: enrollment of registered nursing and advanced nursing
- 32 students of each school or nursing program, divided by the total
- 33 enrollment of all participating schools or nursing programs;
- 34 multiplied by the current fiscal year's appropriation for grants
- 35 under this program.

- 1 The minimum allocation to a school or nursing program is
- 2 \$2,000.
- 3 Subp. 4. Modification of allocations. The director shall
- 4 allocate funds equal to the school's or program's estimated need
- 5 for funds if the estimated need is less than the amount
- 6 determined by the allocation formula.
- 7 Subp. 5. Reallocation. If funds are available, the
- 8 director shall reallocate funds to schools or nursing programs
- 9 requesting additional program funds according to the formula in
- 10 subpart 3.
- 11 Subp. 6. Delay. Failure of a participating school or
- 12 nursing program to submit the annual application for
- 13 participation to the director or provide requested enrollment
- 14 data by the deadline dates will result in the delay of
- 15 notification and disbursement by the director to the school or
- 16 nursing program.
- 17 Subp. 7. Accountability. Each participating school and
- 18 nursing program is accountable for any money disbursed to
- 19 students for nursing grants. The money may be used only during
- 20 the fiscal year of disbursement. If a student does not use a
- 21 grant because the student does not enroll or withdraws from
- 22 school, the school may use the funds for other eligible students
- 23 or must return the funds to the director.
- Subp. 8. Unused funds. When requested by the director, a
- 25 school or nursing program shall report on its use of funds and
- 26 shall return unused funds. The director shall reallocate unused
- 27 funds to schools or nursing programs that desire additional
- 28 funds.

- 31 Subpart 1. Award amount. The minimum award amount is
- 32 \$2,000 per academic year. The maximum award amount is \$4,000
- 33 per academic year.

- 35 4830.9030 REPORTS BY SCHOOLS OR NURSING PROGRAMS.

- 1 Subpart 1. Data collection; reports. The school or
- 2 nursing program must collect demographic, educational, and
- 3 financial data specified by the director from eligible students
- 4 requesting grants, and provide this data to the director upon
- 5 request.
- 6 The director shall require program activity and student
- 7 data reports at the end of each year. The school or nursing
- 8 program must complete and submit the reports and any applicable
- 9 refunds to the director by the first working day after August
- 10 9. If the reports are not completed correctly and submitted by
- 11 the deadline, the director shall withhold the subsequent year's
- 12 allocation until reporting requirements are fully met.
- Subp. 2. Additional information. The director may require
- 14 additional information not inconsistent with law that in the
- 15 director's judgment is helpful to efficiently administer the
- 16 program. The additional information may be required from grant
- 17 applicants or recipients or eligible institutions or programs.
