3 Adopted Permanent Rules Relating to Emergency Medical Technician

6 Rules as Adopted

7 4690.4600 ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES.

8 [For text of subps 1 to 3, see M.R.]

9 Subp. 4. Expiration of certificates. An applicant who
10 successfully completes initial testing shall be assigned an
11 expiration date according to the following schedule:

12 A. for initial testing completed between January 1
13 and June 30 of an even year, the expiration date is March 31 of
14 the next even year;

15 B. for initial testing completed between July 1 and
16 December 31 of an even year, the expiration date is March 31 of
17 the second odd year;

18 C. for initial testing completed between January 1
19 and June 30 of an odd year, the expiration date is March 31 of
20 the next odd year;

21 D. for initial testing completed between July 1 and
22 December 31 of an odd year, the expiration date is March 31 of
23 the second even year; and

24 E. for certificates that are due to expire on
25 December 31, 1995, or December 31, 1996, the expiration date is
26 extended to March 31 of the following year.

28 Subp. 6. Refresher course for renewal of certificate. An
29 applicant for renewal of the certificate must successfully
30 complete an emergency care refresher course approved under part
31 4690.4700 and must pass approved written and practical
32 examinations before the certificate expiration date. Evidence
33 of completion of the requirements in part 4690.4800 must be
34 submitted to the commissioner before the certification
35 expiration date. No person may function as an emergency medical

1 technician on a Minnesota ambulance service without evidence of
2 current certification by the commissioner. An applicant may
3 renew a lapsed registration certificate provided the applicant
4 meets the following requirements:

5 A. within 12 months after the certificate expiration
6 date, complete a refresher emergency care course and
7 successfully complete written and practical skills examinations
8 approved by the commissioner; or

9 B. if more than 12 months have passed since the
10 certificate expiration date, complete an emergency care course
11 and successfully complete written and practical skills
12 examinations approved by the commissioner.

13 4690.5900 ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES.

15 Subp. 4. **Expiration of certificates.** An applicant who
16 successfully completes initial testing shall be assigned an
17 expiration date according to the following schedule:

18 A. for initial testing completed between January 1
19 and June 30 of an even year, the expiration date is March 31 of
20 the next even year;

21 B. for initial testing completed between July 1 and
22 December 31 of an even year, the expiration date is March 31 of
23 the second odd year;

24 C. for initial testing completed between January 1
25 and June 30 of an odd year, the expiration date is March 31 of
26 the next odd year;

27 D. for initial testing completed between July 1 and
28 December 31 of an odd year, the expiration date is March 31 of
29 the second even year; and

30 E. for certificates that are due to expire on
31 December 31, 1995, or December 31, 1996, the expiration date is
32 extended to March 31 of the following year.

34 Subp. 6. **Evidence of compliance.** Evidence of compliance
35 with the requirements in subpart 5 must be completed by the

1 applicant before the expiration date of the certificate.

2 4690.7200 ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES.

4 Subp. 4. Expiration of certificates. An applicant who
5 successfully completes initial testing shall be assigned an
6 expiration date according to the following schedule:

7 A. for initial testing completed between January 1
8 and June 30 of an even year, the expiration date is March 31 of
9 the next even year;

10 B. for initial testing completed between July 1 and
11 December 31 of an even year, the expiration date is March 31 of
12 the second odd year;

13 C. for initial testing completed between January 1
14 and June 30 of an odd year, the expiration date is March 31 of
15 the next odd year;

16 D. for initial testing completed between July 1 and
17 December 31 of an odd year, the expiration date is March 31 of
18 the second even year; and

19 E. for certificates that are due to expire on
20 December 31, 1995, or December 31, 1996, the expiration date is
21 extended to March 31 of the following year.

23 Subp. 6. Evidence of compliance. Evidence of compliance
24 with the requirements in subpart 5 must be submitted by the
25 applicant before the certificate expiration date.
