- 2 Payment of prizes may be by check, draft, cash, or a free
- 3 ticket.
- 4 7857.5000 OWNERSHIP OF LOTTERY TICKETS.
- 5 A lottery ticket is considered to be owned by the person
- 6 who has physical possession of the ticket until a name is
- 7 imprinted or placed on the rear portion of the lottery ticket in
- 8 the area designated. When a name is placed in the designated
- 9 area, the person whose name appears in that area is the owner of
- 10 the ticket and is entitled to any prize attributable to that
- 11 ticket. The lottery will only make payment of a prize to the
- 12 name on the back of the ticket, notwithstanding any name
- 13 submitted on the claim form. If two or more names appear on the
- 14 rear of the ticket, or the owner of the ticket has otherwise
- 15 agreed to share the prize, the prize will be paid as prescribed
- 16 in the game procedures adopted for the game from which the prize
- 17 was won.
