2 Adopted Permanent Rules Relating to the State Lottery

3 7856.4010 CONDITIONS OF RETAILER CONTRACT.

5 Subp. 6. Lost or missing tickets. The lottery retailer
6 shall agree to be responsible for lost, stolen, or missing
7 tickets.

11 7856.6010 CANCELLATION, SUSPENSION, AND NONRENEWAL OF CONTRACT.

13 Subp. 2. Discretionary. A contract or authorization for a
14 lottery retailer to sell lottery tickets at a particular
15 business location may be canceled, suspended, or not renewed if
16 it is determined by the director that the retailer:

18 N. sold, bartered, furnished, or given alcoholic
19 beverages to a person under 21 years of age in violation of
20 Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.503, subdivision 2, clause (1),
21 two or more times within a two-year period.

23 7856.7010 DEPOSIT OF FUNDS.

24 Lottery retailers shall deposit in a bank account all money
25 received by the retailer from the sale of lottery tickets, less
26 the amount retained as compensation for the sale of tickets and

1 credit for direct payment of prizes. The lottery shall have
2 access through electronic funds transfer (EFT) to all money
3 required to be deposited by lottery retailers.

4 7856.7040 AGENTS RESPONSIBLE FOR TICKETS.

5 Tickets accepted by the retailer from the lottery, or its
6 authorized representatives, are considered to have been
7 purchased by the retailer, unless returned within the time
8 specified. The retailer is responsible for lost, stolen, or
9 missing tickets.

10 7857.4000 CLAIM VERIFICATION.

11 The lottery shall verify the information on the claim form
12 and give a copy of the claim form to the claimant. Upon
13 validation by the lottery, a check will be forwarded to the
14 claimant in payment of the amount due subject to the
15 restrictions of payment provided by law. In the event that the
16 claim is not validated, the claim must be denied and the
17 claimant will be notified.

18 7857.4010 CLAIMING A PRIZE.

20 Subp. 2. Claim form. Prizes over \$599 must be paid by
21 filing a claim form provided by the lottery. The claimant shall
22 prepare and submit a claim form and the apparent winning ticket
23 to a lottery office for processing. For certain prizes as set
24 in the game procedures for that particular game, the claimant
25 must submit a claim form and the apparent winning ticket in
26 person at the lottery's headquarters for processing.

1 7857.4040 MANNER OF PAYMENT.

2 Payment of prizes may be by check, draft, cash, or a free
3 ticket.

4 7857.5000 OWNERSHIP OF LOTTERY TICKETS.

5 A lottery ticket is considered to be owned by the person
6 who has physical possession of the ticket until a name is
7 imprinted or placed on the rear portion of the lottery ticket in
8 the area designated. When a name is placed in the designated
9 area, the person whose name appears in that area is the owner of
10 the ticket and is entitled to any prize attributable to that
11 ticket. The lottery will only make payment of a prize to the
12 name on the back of the ticket, notwithstanding any name
13 submitted on the claim form. If two or more names appear on the
14 rear of the ticket, or the owner of the ticket has otherwise
15 agreed to share the prize, the prize will be paid as prescribed
16 in the game procedures adopted for the game from which the prize
17 was won.
