7 aid kit that contains bandages, sterile compresses, scissors, an
8 ice bag or cold pack, an oral or surface thermometer, mild
9 liquid soap, and adhesive tape. A first aid manual must be
10 included. The kit and manual must be accessible and taken on
11 field trips.

14 Subpart 1. Policies given to parents. At the time of a
15 child's enrollment, the parent must be provided with written
16 notification of the:

22 9503.0125 CHILDREN'S RECORDS.

23 At the time of enrollment in the center, the license holder
24 must ensure that a record is maintained on each child. The
25 record must contain:

1 I. the hours and days of the week the child will
2 attend the center;

3 J. for children age six weeks to 36 months, a
4 description of the child's eating, sleeping, toileting, and
5 communication habits, and effective methods for comforting the
6 child;

7 K. documentation of any dietary or medical needs of
8 the child;

9 L. documentation of any individual child care program
10 needs for the child; and

11 M. the date of parent conferences and a summary of
12 the information provided to the parent at the conference.

13 The license holder shall not disclose a child's record to
14 any person other than the child, the child's parent or guardian,
15 the child's legal representative, employees of the license
16 holder, and the commissioner unless the child's parent or
17 guardian has given written consent or as otherwise required by
18 law.

21 Subp. 16. **First aid kit.** The license holder must ensure
22 that a first aid kit is available within the center. The kit
23 must contain sterile bandages and band-aids, sterile compresses,
24 scissors, an ice bag or cold pack, an oral or surface
25 thermometer, and adhesive tape. A current first aid manual must
26 be included. The first aid kit and manual must be accessible to
27 the staff in the center and taken on field trips.

2 9555.9720 SAFETY REQUIREMENTS.

3 Subpart 1. First aid kit. The center shall have a first
4 aid kit that contains a first aid manual, sterile bandages and
5 band-aids, sterile compresses, scissors, an ice bag or cold
6 pack, an oral or topical thermometer, liquid soap, adhesive
7 tape, and money for phone calls. The first aid kit and manual
8 must be accessible to the staff in the center and must be taken
9 on field trips.
