1.6 Subp. 3. **Cancellation.** If the commissioner has good cause to believe that a driver
1.7 or applicant has experienced an episode of loss of consciousness or voluntary control
1.8 as described in subpart 1, or if a physician's report required by subpart 2 indicates an
1.9 unfavorable prognosis for control of the person's condition, the commissioner shall cancel
1.10 or deny the person's driving privileges until three months have elapsed since the episode
1.11 or diagnosis and until the person submits a physician's report that indicates a favorable
1.12 prognosis for episode free control of the person's condition, indicates that the person is
1.13 cooperating in the treatment of the condition, and indicates that the person is medically
1.14 qualified to exercise reasonable and proper control over a motor vehicle on the public
1.15 roads, except as provided in items A to D.
