
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE
LAW JUDGE'S ORDER
ON REVIEW OF RULES
UNDER MINN. STAT.
§ 14.26(3)(b)

The Department of Commerce has adopted the above-entitled rules pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.26. On January 21, 1998, the Office of Administrative Hearings received the documents from the agency required to be filed under Minn. Stat. § 14.26 and Minn. R. 1400.2310. On February 4, 1998, the Administrative Law Judge issued the Order on Review of Rules under Minn. Stat. § 14.26. As set forth in the February 4, 1998, Order, a portion of the rules were disapproved.
