ORDER ON REVIEW

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Ann C. O'Reilly upon the application of the Minnesota Department of Revenue (Department) for a legal review under Minn. Stat. § 14.388 (2020) and Minn. R. 1400.2400 (2021).

On February 22, 2022, the Department filed documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings seeking review and approval of the above-entitled rules under Minn. Stat. § 14.388 and Minn. R. 1400.2400. The submissions were supplemented with a Certificate of Mailing, Certificate of Accuracy of Mailing List, and evidence of compliance with Minn. Stat. § 16E.07, subd. 3 (2020), that same day.

There were no written comments received by the Office of Administrative Hearings. The deadline for filing comments expired on March 1, 2022.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Department,

IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED THAT:

- 1. The rules were adopted in compliance with the legal and procedural requirements of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 14 (2020), and Minnesota Rules, Chapter 1400 (2021).
- 2. Under Minn. Stat. § 14.388, the Department has the statutory authority to adopt these proposed rules using the "good cause exemption" to the rulemaking process. Specifically, the Department's authority rests in Minn. Stat. § 14.388, subd. 1 (3) and (4).
- 3. The Department has complied with the notice requirements of Minn. Stat. § 14.388, subd. 2.
- 4. The proposed rule amendments comply with the standards of Minn. R. 1400.2100, items A and D to G (2021) and Minn. R. 1400.2400.
