**ORDER ON REVIEW OF  
ADDITIONAL NOTICE PLAN  
AND NOTICE OF HEARING**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Eric L. Lipman upon the application of the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (Department) for a legal review under 42 U.S.C. § 6833 (2020) and Minn. Stat. § 14.14, subd. 1 (2020).

On July 11, 2022, the Department filed documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings seeking review and approval of its Additional Notice Plan and Notice of Hearing.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Department, including its plan to notify a wide range of contractors, architects, engineers, environmental advocates and building code officials,


**IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED THAT:**

1. The Additional Notice Plan and Notice of Hearing are well-designed to meet the objectives and record-building requirements of 42 U.S.C. § 6833 (a)(2).
2. Unless there is good cause shown, on the record, the public comment period following the public hearing shall be twenty (20) calendar days.
