**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF RULES UNDER
MINN. STAT. § 14.3895**

This matter came before Chief Administrative Law Judge Jenny Starr upon the request of the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (Department) for a legal review of its proposed repeal of obsolete rules pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.3895 (2020).

On February 7, 2022, the Department filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings a request for review of the form and legality of its repeal of obsolete rules. The Department supplemented its filings on February 8, 2022, to include full copies of all certificates of service and attachments. With the supplementation, the Department filed all required documentation to support the repeal.

Upon review, the Chief Administrative Law Judge finds that all procedural requirements were met and that all notice was provided, including the notices required by the Chief Judge in her Order approving the Department's Additional Notice Plan issued on October 28, 2021.

Therefore, based upon a review of the written submissions and all of the documents in the rulemaking record,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The proposed repeal of obsolete rules is **APPROVED** as to form and legality, and the Department may publish the final rule in the *State Register*.
