ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINE FOR RULE REPORT

This matter came before the Chief Administrative Law Judge upon the request of the Administrative Law Judge to extend the deadline for completing the rule report pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.15, subd. 2 (2020).

The Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board (Board) proposes to amend rules currently governing its determinations regarding changes, improvements, and additions to commemorative works in the Minnesota Capitol Area. The proposed rules came on for a public hearing on March 14, 2022. The rulemaking record closed on April 11, 2022, following the post-hearing comment and rebuttal period. The deadline for completion of the Administrative Law Judge's report is May 11, 2022.
