**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF RULES UNDER
MINN. STAT. § 14.388
AND MINN. R. 1400.2400**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Jessica A. Palmer-Denig upon the request of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) for a legal review of the above-entitled rules under Minn. Stat. § 14.388 (2020) and Minn. R. 1400.2400 (2021).

On November 30, 2021, the MPCA filed required documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings seeking review and approval of its proposed exempt rules. The public comment period closed on December 7, 2021, and the record closed on that date.

Based upon a review of all written submissions,


IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED THAT:

1. The proposed rule amendment incorporates a specific change set forth in 2021 Minn. Laws 1st Spec. Sess. ch. 6, part. 2, § 131.
2. The MPCA has the statutory authority to adopt the rule using the good cause exempt rulemaking process pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.388, subd. 1(3).
3. The rule amendment complies with the procedural requirements of Minn. Stat. §§ 14.386(a)(1)-(4), .388 (2020) and Minn. R. 1400.2100 A, D-G, .2400 (2021).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The adopted rules are **APPROVED**.
