Enclosed herewith and served upon you is the **ORDER ON REVIEW OF RULES UNDER MINN. STAT. § 14.388 AND MINN. R. 1400.2400** in the above-entitled matter. The amendments to the rule parts are exempt from the rulemaking requirements of Minn. R. ch. 1400 (2025) pursuant to the good cause exemption in Minn. Stat. § 14.388, subd. 3 (2024).

With the approval of the adopted rules, the Court of Administrative Hearings has closed this file and is returning the rule record to the Minnesota Department of Public Safety so that the Department can maintain the official rulemaking record in this matter as required by Minn. Stat. § 14.365 (2024). The Department's next step is to arrange for publication of the proposed amendments in the State Register as required by Minn. Stat. § 14.388, subd. 1 (2024).

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Department,


IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED THAT:
