1.2 **Proposed Permanent Rules Relating to Continuing Education**

1.3 **2891.0500 DEFINITIONS.**

1.4 Subpart 1. **Scope.** The definitions in this part apply to parts 2891.0500 to 2891.0510.

1.5 Subp. 2. **Practical experience.** "Practical experience" means an individual's
1.6 personal ability or skill that is derived from actual work in residential contracting,
1.7 residential remodeling, or residential roofing, or lecturing in an approved educational
1.8 offering about residential contracting, residential remodeling, or residential roofing.

1.9 Subp. 3. **Qualified instructor.** "Qualified instructor" means an individual who
1.10 satisfies the education, training, or experience requirement in Minnesota Statutes, section
1.11 326B.821, subdivision 10.

1.12 **2891.0502 EXEMPTION FROM PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE CALCULATION.**

1.13 The practical experience calculation in part 2891.0510 does not apply to a qualified
1.14 instructor who is teaching a course that has been approved pursuant to Minnesota Statutes,
1.15 section 326B.821, subdivision 6, prior to the effective date of part 2891.0510.

1.16 **2891.0510 PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE CALCULATION.**

1.17 For purposes of Minnesota Statutes, section 326B.821, subdivision 10, paragraph (b),
1.18 practical experience must be calculated by the accumulation of 1,200 hours of actual
1.19 work or lecturing in the regulated industry within a 12-month period multiplied by the
1.20 required number of years.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** These rules are effective March 30, 2009, or five working days
1.22 after the notice of adoption is published in the State Register, whichever is later.
