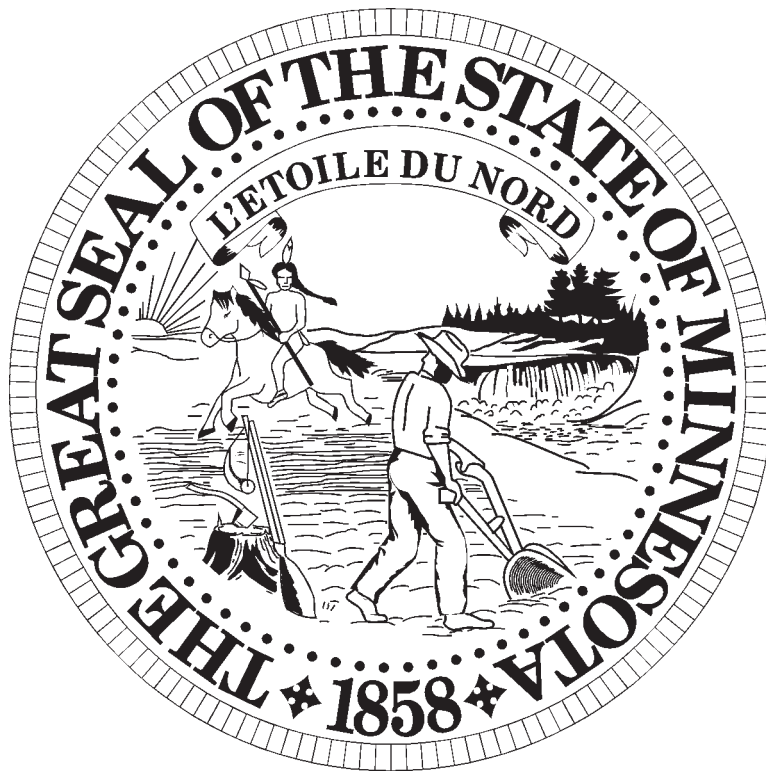

Minnesota Rules: Amendments and Additions

NOTICE: How to Follow State Agency Rulemaking in the State Register

The *State Register* is the official source, and only complete listing, for all state agency rulemaking in its various stages. State agencies are required to publish notice of their rulemaking action in the *State Register*. Published every Monday, the *State Register* makes it easy to follow and participate in the important rulemaking process. Approximately 80 state agencies have the authority to issue rules. Each agency is assigned specific **Minnesota Rule** chapter numbers. Every odd-numbered year the **Minnesota Rules** are published. The current 1999 set is a 13-volume bound collection of all adopted rules in effect at the time. Supplements are published to update this set of rules. Generally speaking, proposed and adopted exempt rules do not appear in this set because of their short-term nature, but are published in the *State Register*.

An agency must first solicit **Comments on Planned Rules** or **Comments on Planned Rule Amendments** from the public on the subject matter of a possible rulemaking proposal under active consideration within the agency (*Minnesota Statutes* §§ 14.101). It does this by publishing a notice in the *State Register* at least 60 days before publication of a notice to adopt or a notice of hearing, or within 60 days of the effective date of any new statutory grant of required rulemaking.

When rules are first drafted, state agencies publish them as **Proposed Rules**, along with a notice of hearing, or a notice of intent to adopt rules without a hearing in the case of noncontroversial rules. This notice asks for comment on the rules as proposed. Proposed emergency rules and withdrawn proposed rules are also published in the *State Register*. After proposed rules have gone through the comment period, and have been rewritten into their final form, they again appear in the *State Register* as **Adopted Rules**. These final adopted rules are not printed in their entirety in the *State Register*, only the changes made since their publication as Proposed Rules. To see the full rule, as adopted and in effect, a person simply needs two issues of the *State Register*, the issue the rule appeared in as proposed, and later as adopted. For a more detailed description of the rulemaking process, see the most current edition of the *Minnesota Guidebook to State Agency Services*.

The *State Register* features partial and cumulative listings of rules in this section on the following schedule: issues #1-13 inclusive; issues #14-25 inclusive; issue #26 cumulative for issues #1-26; issues #27-38 inclusive; issue #39, cumulative for issues #1-39; issues #40-51 inclusive; and issues #1-52 (or 53 in some years), cumulative for issues #1-52 (or 53). An annual subject matter index for rules was separately printed usually in August, but starting with Volume 19 now appears in the final issue of each volume. Expedited Emergency Rules

Provisions exist for the Commissioners of some state agencies to adopt expedited emergency rules when conditions exist that do not allow the Commissioner to comply with the requirements for emergency rules. The Commissioner must submit the rule to the attorney general for review and must publish a notice of adoption that includes a copy of the rule and the emergency conditions. Expedited emergency rules are effective upon publication in the State Register, and may be effective up to seven days before publication under certain emergency conditions.

Expedited emergency rules are effective for the period stated or up to 18 months. Specific *Minnesota Statute* citations accompanying these expedited emergency rules detail the agency's rulemaking authority.

Adopted Expedited Emergency Game and Fish Rules: Fall Wild Turkey Hunting; Prairie Chicken Hunting

Notice is hereby given that the above entitled rules have been adopted through the process prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, section 84.027, subdivision 13 (b). The statutory authority for the contents of the rule is Minnesota Statutes, sections 97A.434, 97A.435, 97B.711, 97B.716, and 97B.723.

The emergency conditions that do not allow compliance with Minnesota Statutes, sections 97A.0451 to 97A.0459, are that population and harvest data needed for setting quotas and areas are not available until June of 2006.

Subp. 4. **Open areas.** Wild turkey permit areas are open for the fall turkey season as prescribed by the commissioner. Turkey licenses are valid for taking turkeys only in the wild turkey permit area specified on the license. Permit areas shall be identified in application materials and on electronically issued licenses by their three digit number. The following wild turkey permit areas are open for the 2006 fall season: 228, 236, 337, 338, 339, 341, 342, 343, 344, 345, 346, 347, 348, 349, 420, 422, 425, 431, 433, 442, 443, 446, 447, 448, 449, 450, 461, 462, 464, 465, 466, and 467.

Subp. 5. **Registration.** Turkeys must be registered within 24 hours after being taken during the fall turkey season.

Subp. 6. **Turkey hunt quotas.** Permit quotas for the 2006 fall season are as follows:

Wild turkey permit areas are comprised of registration blocks with the same numbers, as established in part 6232.4700, except wild turkey permit area 425 consists of registration blocks 425 and 435.

6237.0400 TAKING PRAIRIE CHICKENS.

Subp. 4. **Open areas.** Prairie chicken permit areas are open for the prairie chicken season as prescribed by the commissioner. Prairie chicken licenses are valid only in the prairie chicken permit area specified on the license. Permit areas shall be identified in application materials and on electronically issued licenses by a three digit number plus a letter. The following prairie chicken permit areas are open with prescribed quotas for the 2006 season:

Subpart 1. Area 801A. Prairie chicken permit area 801A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of State Trunk Highway (STH) 1 and STH 32; thence along STH 32 to Pennington County StateAid Highway (CSAH) 3 to Polk CSAH 21; thence along Polk CSAH 21 to United States Highway (US) 75; thence along US 75 to STH 1; thence along STH 1 to the point of beginning.

Subp. 2. Area 802A. Prairie chicken permit area 802A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of Pennington County StateAid Highway (CSAH) 3 and State Trunk Highway (STH) 32; thence along STH 32 to United States Highway (US) 2; thence along US 2 to US 75; thence along US 75 to Polk CSAH 21; thence along Polk CSAH 21 to Pennington CSAH 3; thence along Pennington CSAH 3 to the point of beginning.

Expedited Emergency Rules

Subp. 3. Area 803A. Prairie chicken permit area 803A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of United States Highway (US) 59 and State Trunk Highway (STH) 32; thence along US 59 to US 2; thence along US 2 to STH 32; thence along STH 32 to the point of beginning.

Subp. 4. Area 804A. Prairie chicken permit area 804A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of United States Highway (US) 2 and US 59; thence along US 59 to Polk County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 1; thence along Polk CSAH 1 to State Trunk Highway (STH) 32; thence along STH 32 to US 2; thence along US 2 to the point of beginning.

Subp. 5. Area 805A. Prairie chicken permit area 805A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of United States Highway (US) 2 and State Trunk Highway (STH) 9; thence along US 2 to STH 32; thence along STH 32 to STH 102; thence along STH 102 to STH 9; thence along STH 9 to the point of beginning.

Subp. 6. Area 806A. Prairie chicken permit area 806A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of State Trunk Highway (STH) 9 and STH 102; thence along STH 102 to STH 32; thence along STH 32 to STH 200; thence along STH 200 to STH 9; thence along STH 9 to the point of beginning.

Subp. 7. Area 807A. Prairie chicken permit area 807A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of State Trunk Highway (STH) 9 and STH 200; thence along STH 200 to STH 32; thence along STH 32 to Clay County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 34; thence along Clay CSAH 34 to STH 9; thence along STH 9 to the point of beginning.

Subp. 8. Area 808A. Prairie chicken permit area 808A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of State Trunk Highway (STH) 9 and Clay County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 34; thence along Clay CSAH 34 to STH 32; thence along STH 32 to United States Highway (US) 10; thence along US 10 to STH 9; thence along STH 9 to the point of beginning.

Subp. 9. Area 809A. Prairie chicken permit area 809A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of Clay County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 11 and United States Highway (US) 10; thence along US 10 to State Trunk Highway (STH) 32; thence along STH 32 to STH 34; thence along STH 34 to Clay CSAH 2; thence along Clay CSAH 2 to Clay CSAH 11; thence along Clay CSAH 11 to the point of beginning.

Subp. 10. Area 810A. Prairie chicken permit area 810A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of Clay County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 2 and Interstate Highway 94 (I94); thence along I94 to Ottertail CSAH 24; thence along Ottertail CSAH 24 to Wilkin CSAH 26; thence along Wilkin CSAH 26 to Wilkin CSAH 3; thence along Wilkin CSAH 3 to the point of beginning.

Subp. 11. Area 811A. Prairie chicken permit area 811A consists of that portion of the state lying within the following described boundary: Beginning at the intersection of Ottertail County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 24 and Interstate Highway 94 (I94); thence along I94 to State Trunk Highway (STH) 210; thence along STH 210 to United States Highway (US) 75; thence along US 75 to Wilkin CSAH 3; thence along Wilkin CSAH 3 to Wilkin CSAH 26; thence along Wilkin CSAH 26 to Ottertail CSAH 24; thence along Ottertail CSAH 24 to the point of beginning.

REPEALER. Minnesota Rules, part 6237.0500, is repealed.

EFFECTIVE PERIOD. The emergency amendments to Minnesota Rules, parts 6236.0700, 6236.0810, and 6237.0400, expire December 31, 2006. The repeal of Minnesota Rules, part 6237.0500, expires December 31, 2006. After the emergency amendments and the repealer expire, the permanent rules as they read prior to those amendments or repealer again take effect, except as they may be amended by permanent rule. Minnesota Rules, part 6237.0550, expires December 31, 2006.

Official Notices

Pursuant to *Minnesota Statutes* §§ 14.101, an agency must first solicit comments from the public on the subject matter of a possible rulemaking proposal under active consideration within the agency by publishing a notice in the *State Register* at least 60 days before publication of a notice to adopt or a notice of hearing, and within 60 days of the effective date of any new statutory grant of required rulemaking.

The *State Register* also publishes other official notices of state agencies and non-state agencies, including notices of meetings and matters of public interest.

Notice of Review of Minnesota Rules Containing Outdated Language and Changes

Notice of Review of Minnesota Rules Containing Outdated Language and Changes to be Made by the Revisor of Statutes On May 10, 2005, a bill relating to state government that changes the terminology for mentally retarded, mental retardation, physically handicapped, and similar terms in state statutes (H.F. 487) was passed by the Legislature. The bill was signed by Governor Pawlenty on May 18, 2005. This legislation is now contained in 2005 Session Laws Chapter 56.

Official Notices

The Governor's Council on Developmental Disabilities, Department of Administration, agreed to post notice in the State Register stating that the Office of the Revisor of Statutes will be updating like terminology contained in Minnesota Rules. - exclude prescription drug costs from accumulating toward the annual out-of-pocket maximum benefits (*Minnesota Statutes 62D.095, subdivision 4*)

Section 319 provides federal grant money for nonpoint pollution abatement and water resource restoration.

 - The Section 319 grants do not fund projects whose purpose is primarily water quality monitoring or assessment. However, water quality effectiveness monitoring that is part of an implementation project is allowed and encouraged.
 - This year Section 319 funds will not be used to provide added incentive to practices that are receiving an incentive payment from another government program or source. If a practice is receiving cost-share or incentive funds from another governmental grant program, that practice will not be eligible to receive Section 319 funds solely to increase the level of cost-share or incentive payments. However, Section 319 funds can be used to extend practices that benefit water quality. For example, if another government program is providing incentive to put in a 30 foot buffer, and the effectiveness of the buffer would be significantly improved with a 50 foot buffer, Section 319 funds can pay for the additional 20 foot portion of the buffer only, but not for the original 30 foot buffer.

The PCT is a public interagency group established in *Minnesota Statute* who assists the MPCA in recommending to the Commissioner projects that should receive financial and/or technical assistance. After scoring, proposals are ranked to determine which projects can be funded, based on available dollars. 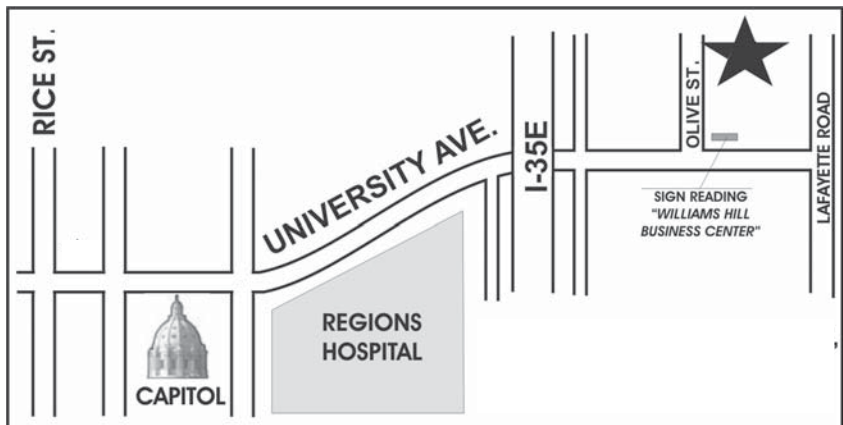

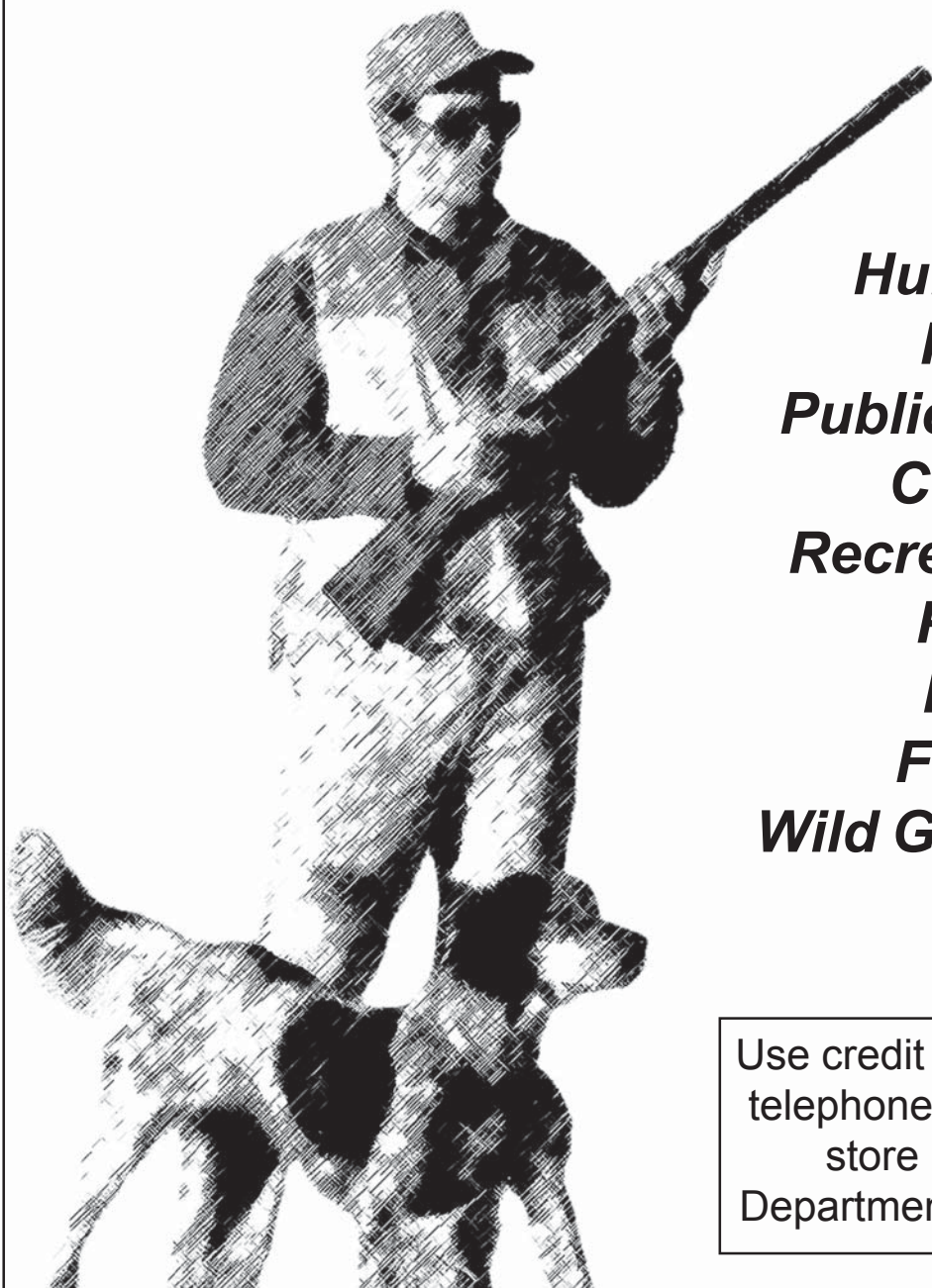
