### CHAPTER 131

#### CLASSIFICATION AND CONDUCT OF SCHOOLS

##### 131.01 PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Amended by L. 1947 c. 633 s. 16.

The term "high school" means any of the five classified high schools specified in this section. 1944 OAG 128, March 15, 1944 (168-D).

One employed as teacher in Ramsey County Home School for Boys may continue to draw retirement annuity under L. 1915 c. 199. OAG Dec. 10, 1945 (175-P).

##### 131.03 DISCONTINUANCE OF JUNIOR COLLEGES.

Once established a junior college course cannot be abandoned except by following procedure prescribed by statute. OAG Feb. 28, 1944 (160-F).

##### 131.12 SPECIAL CLASSES; CRIPPLED CHILDREN.

In applying the amendment L. 1943, c. 251, each particular case, as in cardiac cases, presents the question whether the child is impaired in body. 1944 OAG 123, July 7, 1943 (168).

Upon application of the Minneapolis school board, the commissioner of education may permit the board to establish classes for the crippled children at the Elizabeth Kenny Institute. OAG Aug. 11, 1943 (168).

The school board has the duty and privilege to furnish education, but does not have the burden of support or physical rehabilitation of a crippled child. OAG Oct. 23, 1944 (169-D).

##### 131.13 PHYSICAL AND HEALTH EDUCATION.

As far as the duties of school nurses relate to instruction of pupils or teachers they are controlled by rules of the department of education, but as to matters of health and hygiene they are subject to the rules of the department of health. OAG July 7, 1943 (170-B).

The teacher is not required to administer insulin to a child, nor is a school nurse unless her contract so states. OAG Feb. 27, 1945 (169).

## CLASSIFICATION AND CONDUCT OF SCHOOLS 131.25

If the contract so states, the teacher may teach on certain holidays but cannot be required to teach on Columbus day. OAG Nov. 2, 1945 (168).

### 131.25 SECRET FRATERNITIES AND SOCIETIES.

Secret society defined. OAG Feb. 4, 1944 (161-B-11).

Pupils desiring to enter a high school may be required to pledge or promise that during the time they are students at the school, they will not join a fraternity except as sanctioned by the board. OAG July 9, 1945 (169-e).
