TEXT BOOKS

133.01 LICENSE TO SELL; CONDITIONS.

An "act to provide uniform and cheap text books for the public schools of Minnesota" is constitutional and valid. Curryer v Merrill, 25 M 1.

133.04 FREE TEXT BOOKS; CONTRACT.

Repealed by L. 1947 c. 633 s. 6.

Rules and regulations of the school board relating to free use of school books are in the discretion of the board but must be reasonable and within the spirit of the state law; but there is nothing in L. 1947, c. 633, that indicates a denial of state aid to a school which provided for a deposit to secure the care of and return of books loaned to students.
